A FULL AND UNCONDITIONAL PARDON


FOR HIS CONVICTION in the United States District Court for the District of Utah on a superseding information (Docket No. 2:14CR00470-001 DN) charging violations of Section 371, Title 18, and Section 1701 (mistakenly listed on the judgment as 1702), Title 43, United States Code, for which he was sentenced on December 18, 2015, to 36 months' probation conditioned upon 10 days' incarceration, a \$1,000 fine, \$95,955.61 restitution, and a \$50 special assessment.

I HEREBY DESIGNATE, direct, and empower the Office of the Pardon Attorney, as my representative, to sign a grant of clemency to the person named herein. The Office of the Pardon Attorney shall declare that its action is the act of the President, being performed at my direction.
