- Largest encyclopedia in the world
- About 100,000 contributors around the world
- Approximately 365 million readers worldwide
- Over 19 million articles in over 285 languages
- Free to edit and free to use
- Free of advertisements



Contributors are not paid. They are all **volunteers**.





Contributors (Wikipedians) create and edit articles very often that it would almost impossible to have a team large enough to review and validate every single change made.







Wikipedians <u>help each other</u> to make Wikipedia articles better.





Most active users are driven by their <u>passion to distribute free</u> <u>knowledge</u> to the world.







Volunteers provide content to Wikipedia while the non-profit Wikimedia Foundation supports it.



Create a Wikipedia user account





An account allows you

- To create new articles or pages
- Upload images
- Rename pages
- To get access to special features such as My watchlist
- To have identity and interact with others
- To become a trusted member
- To have more say in discussions







You can edit Wikipedia even without an account but your edits are assigned to your computer's IP address.







It is easy to create an account and your not required to provide any personal information.

- Click Log in/create account, located at the top right side of the page
- Choose your username
- Select your password
- Click Create account

Maintaining a User page is a good way to build trust and provide authenticity to your edits.








Every account has a User page and a My talk page.







You can find the links for these pages at the top right of your browser.








Click **Edit** to write about yourself. Then click **Save page** at the bottom of the screen after writing.













My talk and Talk pages are places where other contributors can have messages for you and you can respond.







Every article has a **Talk** page.

This page is used to communicate about the content of the article and to resolve conflicts.

Life of an article





It starts small and consists of a summary of the topic (overview), a statement that tells why it is notable, and a source outside Wikipedia.







This basic article is called a stub.





As other users add content to an article, it matures to a more detailed article that captures various perspective. Active contributors might nominate the article for a peer review process.







Based on the feedback, the writers plan improvements through the Talk page of an article.







Finally, an article reaches a level where it is so well-written, sourced, and comprehensive, that only experts can add much value to it. These articles might be designated as good articles.







A few articles could be recognized by Wikipedians as featured articles. These high quality featued articles are displayed on the Wikipedia main page.

Attributes of a quality article





Structure

- Providing a clear article structure helps readers find information and assists editors in keeping all aspects of a topic well organized.
- Most quality articles have the following structures:
 - Lead section
 - The body
 - Appendices and footnotes







Content

- Many Wikipedians consider content the most important factor in judging an article's quality.
- To ensure consitent quality, the Wikipedia community created these guidelines:
 - Provide sources
 - Neutral point of view
 - No promotional content
 - No original research







Community

- Wikipedia is freely licensed to the public. That means no editor owns an article.
- Everybody can join in the decision making process.
- For times when concensus is hard to reach, check out the various option available at Help > The Wikipedia community.

Create a new article





There are many topics that do not have an article on Wikipedia. If you feel that a topic in your mind should genuinely included, consider creating the article yourself.







Search the article title. If the article does not exist, you will see the article in red hyperlink. Click the hyperlink to start editing a new article.







Your article will get a good start, if you provide the following:

- 1. Summary of the topic
- 2. Reason why the topic is notable
- 3. Reference to a credible source about the topic







You can use a workspace or sandbox to practice your article until it has the three elements.







To create a sandbox: Go to your User page> Click Edit> Write [[User:<your username>/Sandbox]] > Save page > Click the link you just created. Your now in your sandbox.




How you can help!

- 5. Must not contain only excluded educational content.
