

Russia's war on Ukraine | Population displacement and casualties



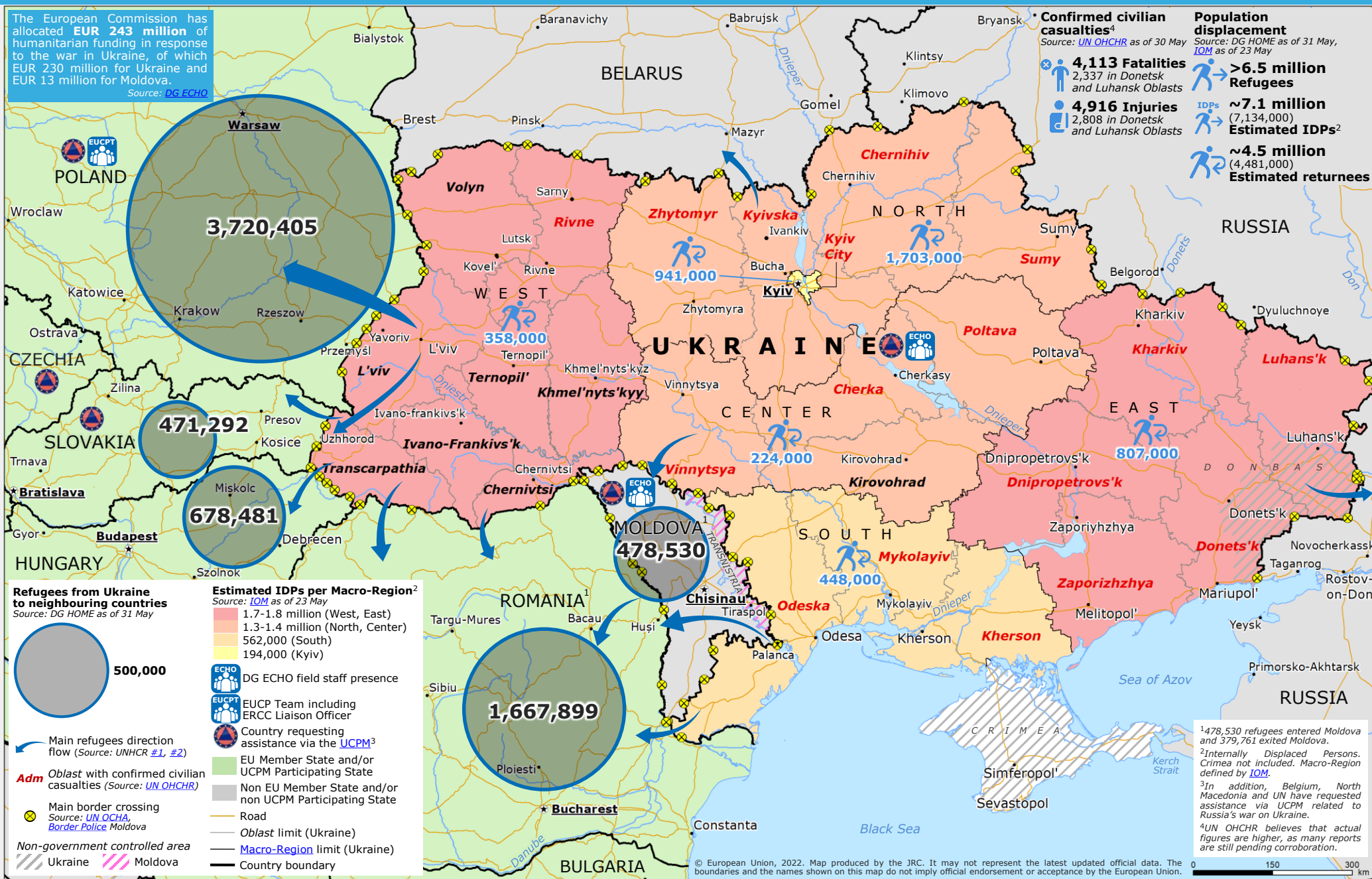
