TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING:

BE IT KNOWN, THAT THIS DAY, I, DONALD J. TRUMP, PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES, PURSUANT TO MY POWERS UNDER ARTICLE II, SECTION 2, CLAUSE 1, OF THE CONSTITUTION, HAVE GRANTED UNTO

ROBERT E. COUGHLIN II

A FULL AND UNCONDITIONAL PARDON

FOR HIS CONVICTION in the United States District Court for the District of Columbia on an information (Docket No. CR 08-111), charging him with violation of Sections 208 and 216(a)(2), Title 18, United States Code, for which he was sentenced on November 24, 2009, to time served, three years' supervised release conditioned upon 30 days in a halfway house and 200 hours' community service, a \$2,000 fine, and a \$100 special assessment.

I HEREBY DESIGNATE, direct, and empower the Office of the Pardon Attorney, as my representative, to sign a grant of clemency to the person named herein. The Office of the Pardon Attorney shall declare that its action is the act of the President, being performed at my direction.
