



تقرير التقييم السادس للجنة الدولية للتغيرات المناخية

من ويكيبيديا، الموسوعة الحرة

تقرير التقييم السادس (AR6) من الفريق الحكومي الدولي المعني بتغير المناخ (IPCC) التابع للأمم المتحدة، هو التقرير السادس في سلسلة من التقارير تهدف إلى تقييم المعلومات العلمية والتقنية والاجتماعية والاقتصادية المتعلقة بتغير المناخ. ساهم 234 عالمًا في هذا التقرير النهائي.[1]

نشرت مجموعة العمل The Physical Science Basis of Climate Change 1 (الأساس العلمي الفيزيائي لتغير المناخ) في 9 أغسطس 2021، والذي ذكر إنه إذا جرى تخفيض البعاثات غازات الاحتباس الحراري إلى النصف بحلول عام 2030 لتصل إلى صافي الصفر بحلول عام 2050، فيمكن إيقاف ظاهرة الاحتباس الحراري. [2] اعتمد مؤلفو التقرير البالغ عددهم 23[3] على أكثر من 14000 ورقة علمية ثم وافقت عليها 195 حكومة. [4] صيغ الملخص الخاص بصانعي السياسات من قبل العلماء وجرت الموافقة عليه سطراً بسطر من قبل الحكومات خلال الأيام الخمسة التي سبقت 6 أغسطس 2021.



Wikimedia Affiliates Environmental Sustainability Covenant

The undersigned Wikimedia affiliates,

- · Affirming that the Wikimedia Movement shares the global responsibility to limit climate change through drastic measures to reduce carbon emissions,
