THE CONSTITUTION (APPLICATION TO JAMMU AND KASHMIR) (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1952.

In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of article 370 of the Constitution of India, the President, in consultation with the Government of the State of Jammu and Kashmir, is pleased to make the following Order, namely:—

1. (1) This Order may be called the Constitution (Application to Jammu and Kashmir) (Amendment) Order, 1952.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. In the Second Schedule to the Constitution (Application to Jammu and Kashmir) Order, 1950, in the entry in the third column relating to Part V, after modification (1), the following modification shall be inserted, namely:—

“(1A) Articles 54 and 55 shall apply, subject to the modifications—

(a) that the references therein to the elected members of both Houses of Parliament and to each elected member of either House of Parliament

shall be deemed to include, respectively, a reference to the representatives of the State in those Houses and to each such representative,

- (b) that the references to the elected members of the Legislative Assemblies of the States and to each such elected member shall be deemed to include, respectively, a reference to the members of the Constituent Assembly of the State and to each such member, and
- (c) that the population of the State shall be deemed to be forty-four lakhs and ten thousand."
