King's Partney Tract Pursuant  
To the Act of Assembly

The Sheriff of this County Together with John  
Montrop, John Brinkerhoff and Robert  
Britt the three freeholder Inhabitants Elected

And Chosen as appears by the Minutes of this Court of the 17<sup>th</sup>  
day of May 1713 have under their hands & seals made return  
of the Map of the partition of the Tract to be divided Together  
with an Apportionment of the Lotts and a list of the Names of the  
Proprietors & Owners among whom the said Tract is to be  
Divided which Map with the said returns Apportionment and  
List Indorsed thereon is now filed with the Clerk of this Court  
Whereupon Mathias Dubois Esq<sup>r</sup> One of the Judges of this  
Court Together with Lawrence Van Kleeck Christophell Van  
Bomelle & Arnout Viles Esq<sup>s</sup> three of the Justices of the same  
Court were pursuant to the Act of Assembly sworn that they  
would do Justice and see Justice done to all persons concerned  
in the Land now to be divided according to the best of their  
knowledge & Understanding
