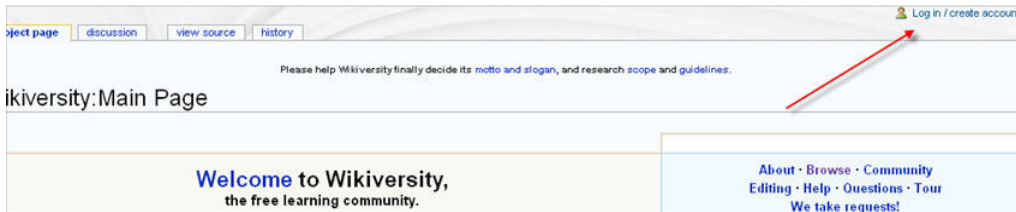
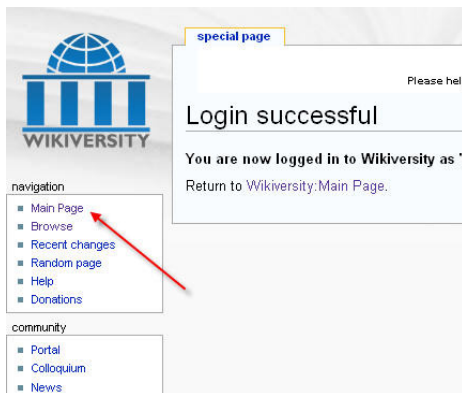


Uploading Files to Wikiversity
