





- Knowledge sharing is highly social
- Future information technology could radically change how knowledge is created, processed and shared
- Movements are built on emotion and human connection

Conclusions New Voices (2)

- As learning platforms evolve, we will need to think beyond the encyclopedia in order to meet the needs of users
- There's a tradeoff between credibility and inclusivity

Conclusies New Voices (3)

- Wikimedia should be an influencer in shaping world policy for access to knowledge
- We are stronger when we work together, but we need direction. Experts believe that Wikimedia should play a leadership role in the open ecosystem
- We need to be prepared for the risk of major societal and political changes in the future

By 2030, Wikimedia will become the essential infrastructure of the ecosystem of free knowledge, and anyone who shares our vision will be able to join us.

We, the Wikimedia communities and organizations, will advance our world by **collecting knowledge that fully represents human diversity**, and by **building the services and structures that enable others to do the same**.

We will **carry on** our mission of creating content as we have done in the past, **and we will go further**.

Strategic Direction (2)

Knowledge as a service:

To serve our users, we will evolve our underlying infrastructure to **become a platform that serves open knowledge to the world** across interfaces and communities.

We will build tools for allies and partners to organize and **exchange free knowledge beyond Wikimedia**.

Our infrastructure will enable us and others to collect and use **different forms of free, trusted knowledge**.

Strategic Direction (3)

Knowledge equity:

As a social movement, we will **focus our efforts on the knowledge and communities that have been left out by structures of power and privilege.**

We will **welcome people from every background** to build strong and diverse communities.

We will **break down the social, political, and technical barriers** preventing people from accessing and contributing to free knowledge.
