My name is Mattias Blomgren, and I am the Chair of Wikimedia Sverige's Board. Wikimedia Sverige is a non-governmental organization committed to the sharing of free knowledge, especially through Wikipedia and the other Wikimedia platforms.

During the last few years, Wikimedia Sverige has dramatically increased its work on sustainability and sustainable development. The start of this work was an international conference we organized in Stockholm in 2019, connecting the work that we do to the Sustainable Development Goals. Realizing the immense importance of knowledge, and the far-reaching impact the knowledge available on platforms such as Wikipedia has, we have also realized the key role that the Wikimedia Movement has to play in the upcoming years, if the world is to change its course towards a sustainable future. The information available on Wikipedia has the potential to shape the views of the citizens of the world. Qualitative information on Wikipedia and the other Wikimedia platforms will be a prerequisite for a sustainable future.

We can, however, not do this alone. We are already working with partners nationally and internationally, such as the Swedish Environmental Protection Agency, UNEP, FAO and others, to improve information on the Wikimedia platforms related to climate change, biodiversity and sustainability. Taking part in Stockholm+50 would be a golden opportunity for the association to extend this network, and to, with the help of others, take the work of providing qualitative knowledge on sustainability to the citizens of the world to the next level.

Leadership dialogue 1: Reflecting on the urgent need for actions to achieve a healthy planet and prosperity for all

Wikipedia. Sverige is the Swedish charity that works to make knowledge accessible through Wikipedia. Wikipedia is one of the most used educational resources in the world. It has 50 million articles across 300 languages[1], which are read 20 billion times a month by 500 million people[2]. It has become an important part of many people's education[3] and increasingly, Wikipedia is playing a role in combating misinformation. Research has shown[4] that a lack of action on climate comes from a lack of understanding of climate change and potential solutions; the perceived costs of implementing policy and behavioral changes; and perceptions of scientific uncertainty.

Wikipedia partners with thousands of organisations around the world to help them share their knowledge. Organisations include universities, museums, libraries, archives, governments, NGOs, and UN agencies. Wikimedia Sverige works internationally and has a special focus on international organisations and technical work. We have dramatically increased our work on sustainability, and are currently working with FAO, UNEP, UNESCO, the Swedish Environmental Protection Agency and others as well as supporting Wiki Loves Earth, the largest environmental photography competition in the world.[5] In 2019 Wikimedia Sverige hosted 900 people at Wikimania (the annual international Wikipedia conference) using the theme of the SDGs.[6]

Attending this meeting will allow us to meet with experts and others to explore how we can work with them to educate the public through Wikipedia, one of the most used educational resources in the world. We would also bring a valuable perspective on the role of online education, especially from an open access and multilingual perspective. We would be very interested in hosting a session, a table or any other opportunity to discuss with other delegates.
