Camberra **vs** **Townsville**
Capitals **vs** **Fire**

The Tradies Camberra Capitals host the Townsville Fire tonight in the third and final of their three regular season meetings as part of Oxian Cancer Australia's Teal Ribbon Round.

Way back in round two the Fire comfortably accounted for the Capitals in North Queensland (78-66) at a time when both teams were still finding their feet and just before Christmas the Fire repeated the dose 68-62 in this very building.

The fortunes of the respective teams have taken severe twists since pre-season predictions were made, with the Capitals arriving tonight on the back of just one win from their last twelve and the Fire having solidified the fourth and final playoff position courtesy of three wins from their past four encounters.

Interestingly tonight's teams are the only ones to inflict defeat on runaway WNBL title favourites Bendigo during the year, the Capitals amazingly winning in Bendigo 59-54 way back in Round 6 and the Fire holding them off in Townsville 56-52 in Round 11.

Agness spark plus Jess Blaby continues to lead the home team in scoring at a lick over thirteen points per game, with versatile forward Brigitte Ardossi hopeful of being back from injury to provide her usual twelve points

and eight rebounds. However, the origin of the other significant statistical input has fluctuated from game to game in a mirror of the Capitals season.

Townsville has a similarly spread range of responsibility amongst Head Coach Chris Lucas' group, though the presence of former Gonzaga University standout Koyla Stondish (13.5 points, almost 7 rebounds and 50% overall shooting) and WNBA centre Jess Adair (Minnesota Lynx) provides two of their most potent weapons.

Last week's frantic struggle here with Bulleen showed that a Capitals win tonight is not out of the question and the team will be keen to try and provide the their fans with a flourish to finish the season.

The Fire has a tough back up against an in form Sydney outfit on Saturday night and though there is only a remote mathematical possibility of them conceding fourth spot, there should be an urgency from the visitors to seal things here in Canberra.

So sit back and enjoy some of the league's best league athletes playing one of the truly world games here at the AIS in Australia's premier women's sporting competition.
