THE RAILROAD CELEBRATION AT BEAR VALLEY.

The celebration of which notice has been given in the last issue of the Gazette, proved a perfect success and a splendid affair. Preparations commenced early in the morning, visitors from all parts of Mariposa county were arriving, and proceeded to the fair lakes of the river, and part down to the mills on the river. Mr. and Mrs. CURTIS, Mr. and Mrs. SMITH came on horseback from Coulterville, and when they arrived at the Benton mills, they were conveyed in two cars up to the mines. Another party, coming from Coulterville, consisting of the fair ladies of that town, (as my humble opinion) and several gentlemen, were too late to get up with the cars, and therefore concluded to await the "train-train," which was to start at 11 o'clock, by the river. Extensive preparations had been made for the occasion, to refresh visitors with all kinds of eating and drinking, and in fact, there was a battery of twenty-four pounders of lager beer, lemonade by the hundred, champagne by the hundred; all kept cool with ice, and cold meats, cheese, pies and other delicacies for the million. Two mammoth tables had been erected under a shed, directly under the hills where the cars were to stop, and here Mr. Hays had displayed his gastronomic talents and good taste.

The train at the mines was delayed by some cause, probably by the insufficient number of carriages to bring the ladies from the Valley to the mines. It did not start until about 12 o'clock, when the "Las Mariposas" was hoisted on the principal car, under the thunder of cannon fire, by the lady of the day, the accomplished Miss Lily Fremont. The train started off, Col. James giving the lead in the first car, which was occupied by the principal persons, viz: Miss Lily Fremont, Mrs. Park and daughter, Mrs. Jones, Mr. PARK, and the least member of the train, Mr. ANSON, the flag "Las Mariposas" floating above the train. Then followed 20 other cars with ladies and gentlemen from Mariposa, Coulterville, Hornitos and Bear Valley, also the engineer of the road, Maj. M. Fremont, with family, and the workmen from the mines, having the Stars and Stripes billowed in the middle car. Mine guns were fired till the train arrived at the river, from one of the hills between the mines and the mills. By the arrival of the train, which was indeed a beautiful sight, cheer and jubilation were the order of the day. After the train had passed, the ladies were brought to the refreshment shed, where, after some talk, and "dashing about" some lager, lemonade, etc. Col. JAMES invited the assemblage to "help themselves," respectively, to "pitch in" to George's Bivings, and to have their own refreshment, and then the ladies, after this Col. James read some resolutions or regular as they were responded by the persons called for in an able manner. After each of these speeches, which were quite numerous, a gun was fired, the orator cheered, and a bottle of champagne opened. The remarks of Mr. Park were most appropriate to the occasion, giving credit to all the works, now completed and in perfect working order, to Col. FLEMING'S talent, ability and perseverance.
