1. Application is submitted by Nippon Denki Yakin KK, No. Sa 1, Naruwa-cho, Kanazawa-shi, Ishikawa-ken, Code No. 15-6 for the release and sale of land and buildings housing Repara-tions Equipment.

2. Subject plant has asked for permission to concentrate all their equipment into one building, with the exception of thirteen (13) trans-formers which are presently being used for silk reeling, as outlined in the application (Plant Layout) with custody and control by Nippon Denki Yakin KK after the release. Protection, maintenance and preservation of equipment can be satisfactorily maintained in the subject building.

3. Subject plant was established in 1930 by Nitto Boseki KK and in 1936 enterprised and corporated with Nippon Denki Yakin KK to contin-ue the manufacture of silk thread. On 1 Jan 1944 the concern was purchas-ed by Nippon Denki Yakin KK and converted into an air craft factory sole-ly for the purpose of manufacturing various air craft parts. Since the termination of war subject plant was granted a permit to reconvert by I Corps and to produce silk thread.

4. The continued uninterrupted production of silk thread in the opinion of this headquarters is important for the future economy of the local area. Should present plans materialize within twelve months the new company would use approximately five hundred (500) employees capable of producing 3154 lbs of silk thread monthly. Planned production also consists of 100,000 yds of woven material per month.

2. Subject plant was established in 1930 by Nitto Boseki KK and in 1936 enterprised and cooperated with Nippon Denki Yakin KK to continue the manufacture of silk thread. On 1 Jan 1944 the concern was purchased by Nippon Denki Yakin and converted into aircraft production solely for the purpose of manufacturing various aircraft parts.

3. Since the termination of war, subject plant was granted a permit to reconvert from war production to essential civilian commodities from Headquarters I Corps to immediately start production of silk thread. Fifty percent (50%) of the machinery are now installed and in operation, and the maximum production currently authorized is 9,719 pounds. It is not known the degree of difficulty which will be encountered for the continued operation, if one (1) piece of machinery air compressor (which will be used to manufacture parts of spinning machine) be removed for reparation. Continued operation of subject plant is important for the future economy of local area.

4. This headquarters is forwarding the application for your consideration. Subject plant has made one previous application for the removal of 13 transformers from reparations.
