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Wakasugi asked whether China's intentions had already been ascertained with respect to the matter. In reply, Hull said that China had not yet been consulted on the matter, it being entirely his own personal idea, but that, if it was carried into effect, it would constitute a good example of the maintenance of peace in the Pacific and have a favorable influence on the world. There is some reason to think, however, that it may have been as a result of having ascertained China's intentions in the matter that Hull's idea was brought forward.
