SUBJECT: Implementation of Directives Concerning Textiles

1. Reference is made to the following directives from General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers, to the Imperial Japanese Government:

a. File No. AG 091 (15 Sep 45) MG, (SCAFIN 29), dated 15 September 1945, subject, Production in Non-War Plants; paragraphs 3a, b, d, and 4c.

b. File No. AG 387.7 (22 Sep 45) CS, (SCAFIN 47), Economic Directive to Japan, (Directive No. 3), dated 22 September 1945; paragraph 3a.

c. File No. AG 091.3 (25 Sep 45) ESS, (SCAFIN 53), dated 25 September 1945, subject, Operation of Manufacturing Industries.

Direct communication is authorized between the Textile Bureau, Ministry of Commerce and Industry, the Raw Silk Bureau, Ministry of Agriculture and Forestry of the Imperial Japanese Government, and the Textile Division of the Economic and Scientific Section, General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers; on all matters involving or pertaining to the explanation, interpretation or implementation of directives listed above.
