MEMORANDUM:

TO : All Section Chiefs

SOP for Setting Up Trips in Special Cars

The policy of this headquarters is to furnish operational sections with the maximum personnel consistent with the overall limitations established by higher headquarters and retain a minimum in the administrative section. Operational sections must thus accept responsibility for some administrative details pertaining to their respective sections.

The use of special railroad cars for surveillance trips involves certain administrative details and some preparation, which must of necessity be the responsibility of the section or sections requesting their use.

Procedures in securing the use of special cars will be as follows:

1. Section Chief will prepare request for transportation showing:
 - a. Using section, listing personnel.
 - b. Proposed itinerary, with schedule and dates.
 - c. Provide an alternate schedule of dates if possible.
2. Present foregoing to Chief Civil Affairs Officer for approval. When approval for the trip and the use of the car has been secured the section will be notified.
3. The section chief will then appoint one member of the section to act as train quartermaster, who will coordinate the details of the projected trip. He will,
 - a. Secure necessary travel orders from the Sgt. Major (Sgt. Mikal or Mr. Futsui).
 - b. Arrange supplying of car, with rations, bedding, fuel, and other requirements with the supply Sgt. at the compound. Sgt. Reider (3-6340) or Mr. Welniak (3-6340).
 - c. Check with RTO to ascertain supplies are delivered, and that car is spotted for departure with proper train. Lt. Baker (3-6279) or Sgt. King (3-6270) at RTO.
 - d. Before the trip, pick up and deliver to individual in charge of the party the necessary ration accounting forms. After the trip deliver executed forms and cash collected for rations to Sgt. Reider or Mr. Welniak.

- e. Inspect car before the trip to see that supplies, facilities and car crew are in order and ready for the trip.
4. Car boys and cooks on special cars are carried as Category II employees, requiring a service charge when services are rendered. There will be a service charge of 5¢ per meal for each meal served aboard the car. Meals will thus be charged at the rate of 45¢ for each meal.
5. At the expiration of each trip the train quartermaster will check car for damages or needed repairs, and supervise the return to the compound of unused subsistence, equipment (bedding etc.) and any other supplies drawn for the trip.




