On or about 15 Sep 1949 the Medical Books listed on this Report of Survey, were placed in the Public Health Section of the Civil Affairs Unit at second floor of the City Hall building (Kagoshima city) for the use of Public Health personnel and Japanese for ready medical purposes. In many instances all Public Health personnel assigned were required to be absent from the section and references were needed by Japanese Physician. These publications were not kept under lock and were accessible to all personnel. Due to rapid turned over of public health personnel of this unit and the many Japanese personnel who handled these publications it was impossible to keep a constant check on the above said books.
