SUBJECT: Inactivation of I and IX Corps

TO : Commanding General
Eighth Army
APO 343

1. Reference is made to the Eighth Army study on inactivation of I and IX Corps, as discussed in conference between Colonel Landrum, Chief of Staff, Eighth Army and Brigadier General E. K. Wright, Assistant Chief of Staff, G-3, General Headquarters, Far East Command, on 29 December 1949.
2. This headquarters approves subject plan in principle and desires that action be initiated toward phasing out the two Corps Headquarters and Corps units concerned, with a completion date of 31 March 1950.
3. A review of the plan indicates that further staff coordination is required with respect to the attachment of various units to divisions and/or Eighth Army.
4. With reference to a relocation of division headquarters, 7th and 25th Divisions, the matter should be more fully considered from the standpoint not only of area control but from the standpoint of strategic requirements, psychological effects, logistic facilities and training considerations. It is desired that this matter be given further study and a firm recommendation submitted prior to 10 January 1950.
5. It is realized that, due to additional logistic and area responsibilities, it may be necessary to provide some augmentation of division staffs and the General Staff Sections of Headquarters, Eighth Army. At the present time there are a considerable number of vacancies in the General Headquarters Staff for senior field officers and it is desired that full consideration be given to an equitable distribution of officers made available through the action contemplated.
6. Consideration must also be given to the control and retention of personnel with special Military Occupational Specialty classification. It seems desirable, for example, to retain the linguist detachments, even if necessary to attach them to divisions. If deactivated in part they

should be reassigned to the 319th MIS Company. It is realized that other considerations will arise in connection with personnel, operations, training and supply. It is desired that all phases of this action be closely coordinated between the appropriate staff sections of your headquarters and those of General Headquarters, Far East Command.

7. Your plan for this action, in final form, should be submitted in triplicate to this headquarters prior to 15 January 1950. This requirement does not prevent the immediate initiation of the action concerned.
