SUBJECT : Amendment of Memorandums on Civil and Criminal
Jurisdiction

1. Reference is made to:

a. Memorandum for the Imperial Japanese Government, AG 015
(19 Feb 46)LS, subject: "Exercise of Criminal Jurisdiction," (SCAPIN
756), and

b. Memorandum for the Imperial Japanese Government, AG 015
(26 Feb 46)LS, subject: "Exercise of Civil Jurisdiction." (SCAPIN
777).

2. The following amendments are directed:

a. In Memorandum, subject: "Exercise of Criminal Jurisdic-
tion," referred to in paragraph 1-a, above, delete in paragraph 6
thereof, "a reasonable suspicion" and substitute therefor, "reason-
able evidence."

b. In Memorandum, subject: "Exercise of Civil Jurisdiction,"
referred to in paragraph 1-b, above, delete paragraph 1-b.

3. Except as otherwise provided herein, the provisions of the
Memorandums referred to in paragraph 1, above, shall continue in full
force and effect.
