Rules

The article should be about any topic concerning an <u>Asian country</u>. The article is <u>newly created</u> by you (i.e. not expanding stubs) between November 1, 2020 0:00 and November 30, 2020 23:59 (UTC).

Rules

The article should be at least <u>3,000 bytes</u> and at least <u>300 words</u> (or characters in some language) in length. (excluding infobox, templates, etc.)

Rules

The article must fulfill the <u>notability criteria</u>. The article must have <u>decent references</u>; doubtful or controversial statements in the article should be verifiable by the citation(s) listed in that article.

Rules

The article should <u>not be a list</u>, but creating a list that becomes a <u>featured list</u> counts. (Only applies in Wikipedias that have featured lists)

Rules

The article <u>must not be purely machine</u> <u>translated</u> and should be properly copy edited. There must be no major issues with the article (<u>no copyright violations</u>, <u>questions of notability</u>, etc.)

Rules

In a nutshell: <u>Create new articles</u> relating to Asia (people, places, culture, etc.), <u>3,000 bytes</u> and <u>300 words</u> minimum, with <u>sources</u>, during November 2020. <u>Lists do not qualify.</u>
