




To the Officers and Enlisted Men of Childress Army Air Field:

JOHN W. WHITE COLONEL, Commanding Officer

Colonel John W. White, Commanding Officer of the Army Air Forces Bombardier School near Childress, is a pioneer in the World War II type of bombing which has made America's "Hell from Heaven Men" the most accurate and most deadly bombardiers of the world's battlefronts.

Rated as senior aircraft pilot, aerial observer, aerial gunner, navigator and expert bombardier, he knows from experience the close coordination necessary from all individuals of the crew to execute a successful mission.

Graduating from West Point, class of 1934, as a Second Lieutenant of Infantry, White applied for flight training and started his flying career at Randolph Field. He completed his advanced training at Kelly Field in 1935, and received his wings as a pilot of the United States Army.

On October 14, 1935, he was assigned to the 32nd Bombardment Squadron of the now famous 19th Bombardment Group, then stationed at March Field, California. As a member of the 19th Bombardment Group White received the foundation for the part he was later to play in the development of modern aerial bombardment.

While serving at March Field in 1937, White was assigned to the communications school at Chanute Field, Rantoul, Illinois, completing his work in June, 1938. Having received his promotion to First Lieutenant, he was assigned to Randolph Field to the 52nd School Squadron, department of training. Until 1940 he served at Randolph and Kelly Fields as instructor of pilots.

In 1940 White was among several officers assigned to Lowry Field, Colorado,

for temporary duty as instructors in the air corps technical school in connection with the training of student bombardier instructors. It was at Lowry that much of the foundation was prepared for the present West Texas Bombardier quadrangle, the Midland, San Angelo, Big Spring and Childress schools. While on duty at Lowry White was promoted to Captain.

Completing the work at Lowry, White was assigned to Ellington Field where he assisted in laying out the bombing and gunnery ranges of that school, and in June, 1941, was named director of bombardier training at Ellington. The following month he received his gold leaf.

In November of 1941 Major White was transferred to Midland, the first school of the famous quadrangle. At Midland he was promoted to Lieutenant Colonel and served as director of flying. In May, 1942, he was transferred to Big Spring as director of training, and assumed command of the Childress School on November 16, 1942.

He was promoted to the temporary rank of Colonel in August, 1943.

Colonel White is a native of Uvalde, Texas, and attended St. Edwards University and Texas A. and M. before entering the Academy.

The Childress Bombardier School received its first class of cadets late in February, and was dedicated February 14 by Brigadier General Isaiah Davies. First practice bombs were dropped March 17 by the "Valentine of Steel" class, which has pledged itself to deliver a "Valentine" of demolition bombs to Hitler & Co.

HISTORY OF CHILDRESS ARMY AIR FIELD

February 14, 1943, Brigadier General Isaiah Davies, Commanding General, 34th Flying Training Wing, assisted by Mrs. John W. White, released a red, white and blue bomb from the radio control tower of Childress Army Air Field.

As the "Valentine of Steel" bomb, dedicated to Hitler and Hirohito, plunged to the ground, a new bombardier college, pulsating with the roar of twin-engine AT-11 bombing trainer planes, came to life in the presence of 16,000 Panhandle residents.

To Lieutenant Colonel John W. White, commanding officer, and Lieutenant Colonel L. H. Dalton, director of training, it was only the beginning. Even on that bleak February day, military uniforms were new to the Childress area. Army personnel consisted only of a few cadres of enlisted men who had arrived in January, and key officer personnel necessary for the activation of a new station.

All the loose ends of months of building and planning, coordinated for the purpose of training lethal-minded young men to blast the Axis, took concrete form during the week of February 14-20.

On February 20 at 1430 a troop train halted on the spur track inside the post. Class 43-7 unloaded. "The Valentine of Steel" class started training. The West Texas Bombardier Triangle—Midland, Big Spring and San Angelo—became the "West Texas Quadrangle," with Childress the fourth.

Actual construction of Childress Army Air Field was started in early summer of 1942 under direction of Captain James E. West, area engineer.

Colonel J. M. Price, then Lieutenant Colonel, came to Childress in August as project officer. Until November, a small group of officers and enlisted men transacted essential duties of the skeleton field. The post was officially activated October 27, 1942.

November 16 at 12 noon Lieutenant Colonel John W. White transferred from Big Spring where he was director of training and assumed command of Childress Army Air Field. From

that day on all activity of the growing post pointed toward actual start of Bombardier training in February.

In mid-December post headquarters was removed from temporary barracks to its permanent location.

Lieutenant Colonel L. H. Dalton, director of training, arriving December 24, was followed by key flying officers who organized training squadrons, ground school and rushed to completion the extensive bombing target ranges.

Although the newest school of the Army Air Forces Central Flying Training Command Bombardier layout, Childress, within a few short months, claimed several "firsts" in training activities.

Cadet combat maneuvers at a base on the Texas Caprock, developed by Colonel Dalton and Lieutenant Colonel James Isbell, then director of flying, proved so successful similar maneuvers were made a part of the Flying Training Command bombardier school training programs.

The first graduating class of Childress Army Air Field made the best record of any first class of older bombardier schools.

May 23, 1943, Childress was host to eight schools of the Army Air Forces Flying Training Command competing in the first All-America Precision Bombing Olympic. A side-feature of the program which received nation-wide attention was a skip-bombing demonstration with practice bombs. Childress pilots and bombardiers performed over Lake Childress, skipping bombs at a 20-foot float target which was completely wrecked by repeated bulls-eyes.

Class 43-12 reported to Childress Army Air Field as the first group of cadets to begin training as Bombardier-Navigators. The previous three months training program was increased to four and one-half months.

Flying day and night over 5,700 square miles of target ranges for bombardier training, and charting navigation flights in all directions of the compass, bombardier-navigator students of Childress Army Air Field will be the vanguard of a new and more efficient Axis Buster.



Lieutenant Colonel L. H. Dalton, director of all departments of Childress Army Air Field which have to do with training of bombardier-navigator cadets, has a background which makes him peculiarly qualified for his important task.

Colonel Dalton graduated from Kansas State College, majoring in business administration, and lettering in football and basketball. He did two years of postgraduate work at Ottawa University and also coached athletics before entering aviation training. In 1936 he completed his primary and basic training at Randolph Field, and in February, 1937, graduated from Kelly Field. From February to October of that year, he was a member of the 94th Pursuit Squadron at Selfridge Field, Michigan; and from the latter date until September, 1940, he was instructor in primary and basic training at Randolph.

Work as assistant air corps supervisor with the Tulsa (Oklahoma) Air corps training detachment claimed his attention until February, 1941, followed by similar work in Muskogee, Oklahoma, and Coleman, Texas.

In November, 1941, Colonel Dalton was made commanding officer of the 67th School (now bombardier training) squadron at Goodfellow Field at San Angelo. In August, 1942, he took bombardier training at Midland, and was made training group commander at San Angelo. He reported to Childress December 22 to assume his present post.

Colonel Dalton was commissioned in the Infantry reserve in 1933 and received a reserve commission in the Air Forces in 1937. This was converted to a Regular Army commission in 1938.
