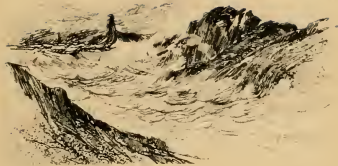

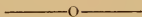

There needs no crown to mark the forest's king.*

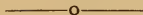
