On 2-12-70, Dr. DAVID R. SHIRLEY, Professor and
Head of the Chemistry, University of Tennessee (UT),
Knoxville, Tennessee, advised SA HOWARD A. MCKAMEY that
subject obtained his PhD degree from Louisiana State University
and did post-doctoral work at the University of Wisconsin,
Madison, Wisconsin. He stated he is an associate professor
at UT in the Chemistry Department and has been so employed
for approximately ten years and is also a consultant with the
Oak Ridge National Laboratory (ORNL), Oak Ridge, Tennessee,
believed to be connected with the Atomic Energy Commission
(AEC).

He stated that subject came to this country as a
displaced person with his parents just after World War II
and that the majority of his relatives resided in the North-
eastern part of the United States. He stated subject is a
white Russian and his parents were both medical doctors;
however, they did not practice after they arrived in this
country. He said that the father of the subject is deceased.

He advised that subject does research work with
graduate and post-doctoral students in both organic and
analytical chemistry; however, he is not connected with
research in the chemical warfare field. He stated that subject
served in the United States Air Force and that he believes
he has a security clearance in connection with his work
at Oak Ridge National Laboratory, Oak Ridge, Tenn.

He advised subject is a person of good character,
reputation and associates and that he has never heard any
derogatory information concerning him since he has been
connected with UT.

On 3-6-70, SA HENRY A. QUINN reviewed the Security Files of the AEC, Oak Ridge, Tennessee, and it was ascertained that GLEB MAMANTOV was granted a Q clearance by the AEC on 9-17-62 in connection with a research participant program with the Oak Ridge Institute of Nuclear Studies. This clearance was terminated on 9-24-64 and reinstated on the same day in connection with a consultant's contract with the ORNL.
