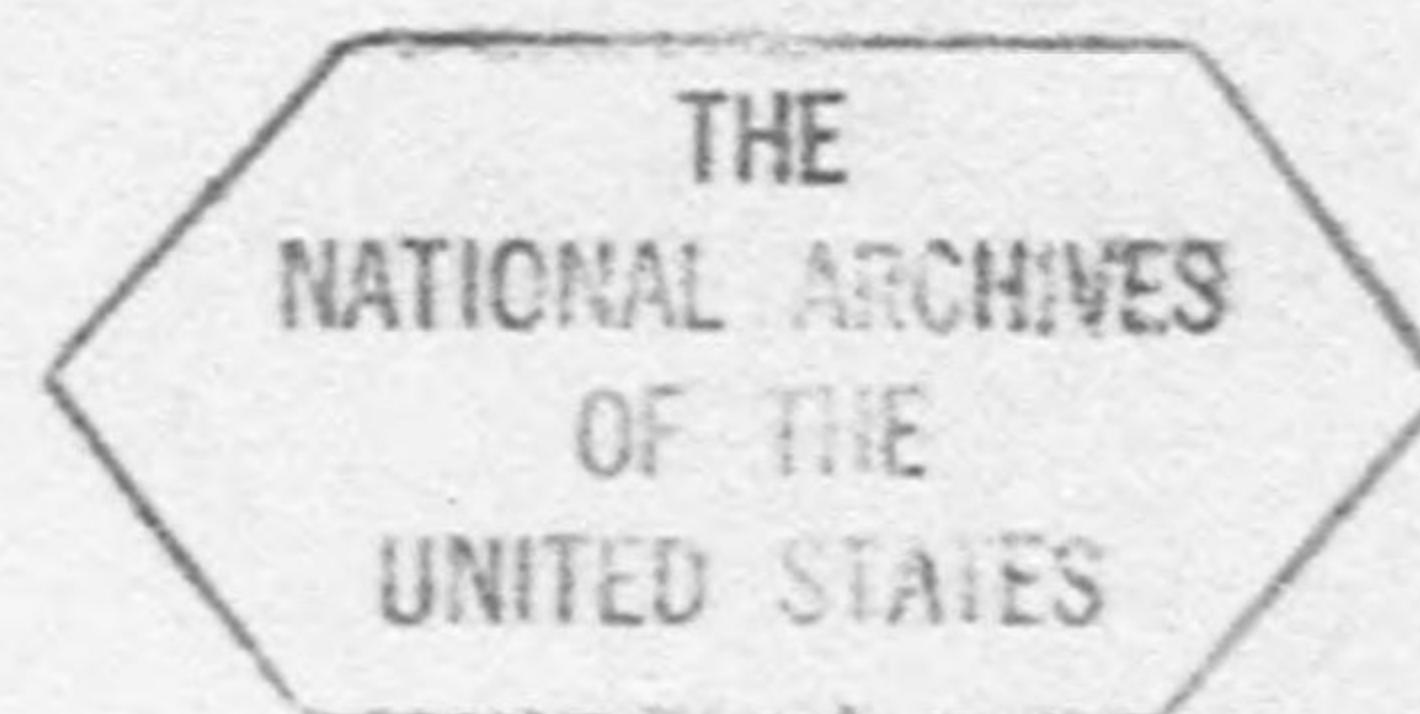

Effective 19 June 1950 and until further notice operation of subject refineries in excess of monthly rates as determined from rates stipulated in reference memoranda will not be authorized without prior approval of Economic and Scientific Section, General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers. For example, a refinery authorized to operate at a rate of 4,000 barrels per calendar day will process only 120,000 or 124,000 barrels per month depending on the number of days in the current month.

1. Reference is memorandum for the Japanese Government from General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers, AG 463.7(13 Jul 49)ESS/IND, SCAPIN 6983-A, subject: Operation of Pacific Coast Refineries and Import of Crude Petroleum, 28 November 1949.

2. One cargo of crude petroleum of approximately 105,000 barrels originally scheduled for discharge at the Shimizu refinery of Toa Kenryo Company has been diverted for discharge at the Yokohama refinery of Nippon Oil Company due to inability of the former to receive the cargo as scheduled.

3. The Yokohama refinery of Nippon Oil Company will completely process the crude petroleum received as noted above in addition to its scheduled amount of 4,000 barrels per calendar day by no later than 30 June 1950.
