MEMORANDUM FOR: JAPANESE GOVERNMENT

SUBJECT: Japanese Overseas Radiotelephone Service

1. Reference is made to Memorandum for the Japanese Government, file AG 311.3 (6 Dec 47) CCS, SCAPIN 1830, dated 6 December 1947, subject same as above, as amended.

2. Radiotelephone calls between Japan and the point listed in inclosure 1 attached hereto, via the United States, are authorized, effective 1 June 1948.

3. All provisions of SCAPIN 1830/2 applicable to calls between Japan and the points listed in inclosure 1, thereto, will apply equally to calls between Japan and the point listed in inclosure 1 of this memorandum.

4. Direct communication between the Civil Communications Section or the General Accounting Section, General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers, and the Ministry of Communications, regarding operating and accounting procedures within the scope of this memorandum, is authorized.
