ORDINANCE NO. 2022-15

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 64 (F), ARTICLE X OF ORDINANCE NO. 2013-10, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE "ALAMINOS CITY TOURISM CODE OF 2013," PARTICULARLY RENTAL RATES OF MOTORBOATS FERRYING GUESTS TO THE HUNDRED ISLANDS NATIONAL PARK

WHEREAS, as the home of the world famous Hundred Islands National Park (HINP), the City of Alaminos has been a prime tourist destination in the Province of Pangasinan;

WHEREAS, in its vision to be a prime tourism hub, the Sangguniang Panlungsod of the city duly enacted Ordinance No. 2013-10 otherwise known as the "Alaminos City Tourism Code of 2013" on 11 November 2013;

WHEREAS, paragraph F of Section 64 thereof provides for the rental rates of motorboats based on boat capacity ferrying guests to the HINP as follows:

BOAT CAPACITY	DAY TOUR	SERVICE BOAT	OVERNIGHT
Small (1-5 passengers)	PhP 1,000.00	PhP 1,400.00	PhP 2,000.00
Medium (6-10 passengers)	PhP 1,300.00	PhP 1,800.00	PhP 2,500.00
Large (11-15 passengers)	PhP 1,500.00	PhP 2,000.00	PhP 3, 000.00

WHEREAS, the continuing increase in the prices of fuel and basic commodities caused local motorboat operators to persistently request for possible intervention from the City Government to alleviate their economic situation and sustain their source of income;

WHEREAS, aware of the current situation, the august body deemed it necessary to respond to such request while considering the possible effects in the local tourism sector;

WHEREFORE, on motion of Councilor Carolyn D. Sison, duly seconded by all members present

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD OF THE CITY OF ALAMINOS, PANGASINAN IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. TITLE. — This Ordinance shall also be known as “*Ordinance Amending Rental Rates of Motorboats Ferrying Guests to the Hundred Islands National Park.*”

SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. — The provision of paragraph F Section 64 of Article X of Ordinance No. 2013-10 which reads as follows:

Large (11-15 passengers)	PhP 1,500.00	PhP 2,000.00	PhP 3, 000.00

Shall be amended to read as follows:

BOAT CAPACITY	DAY TOUR	SERVICE BOAT	OVERNIGHT
Small (1-5 passengers)	PhP 1,400.00	PhP 1,600.00	PhP 2,000.00
Medium (6-10 passengers)	PhP 1,800.00	PhP 2,000.00	PhP 2,500.00
Large (11-15 passengers)	PhP 2,000.00	PhP 2,400.00	PhP 3, 000.00

SECTION 3. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. — If any subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of the ordinance, or its application to any person or circumstance, is for any reason, held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of the ordinance, including its application to other persons or circumstances.

SECTION 11. REPEALING CLAUSE. — All ordinances, resolutions, executive orders, memorandum circulars and all other issuances or parts thereof which are inconsistent with any provision of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 12. EFFECTIVITY. — This Ordinance shall take effect upon compliance with statutory requirements in the enactment of an ordinance.
