GLOW: PROJECT TIGER 1.0 & 2.0 IN INDIA

Partnership model: Content Creation by Growing Local Language Content (GLOW)

Partnership Description:

• From 2017-2018 and 2019-2020, in partnership with Google, WMF hosted a 3-month-long writing contest in India in order to increase locally relevant and high-quality articles in Indian languages.

- As part of the contest, local communities also hosted onsite edit-a-thons where people gather face-to-face to work on the articles together.
- Prizes: monetary incentives and 3-day capacity event for the winning communities

Results: PT 1.0 - 4,000 articles were created in 14 languages PT 2.0 - 12,000 articles were created in 16 languages

Partnerships/Ideas

Other Partnership Opportunities/Ideas:

- Exploring out a new university-based translation program for MENA region aimed at creating Arabic content, testing editor recruitment, and retention strategies
 - Students will be integrated into their local Wiki community; participate in seminars and training activities; and receive one-to-one guidance.
 - Pilot will seek to attract new editors to the movement, with new strategies for recruitment and deeper engagement over time.
- Content Campaigns: #1Lib1Ref
- **Digital Skills Training:** Wikipedia in Classroom: teacher training to foster information literacy skills. This pilot program was implemented in Bolivia, Morocco and the Philippines.
- Moleskine Foundation: translated COVID related Wikipedia articles into local African languages through an online translation campaign for 49 African languages
- **Strategic Partnerships**: in LATAM, we joined the IDB´s<u>21st Century Skills</u> <u>Coalition</u> with a focus on education. This allows us to explore technical integrations (WP Preview) and work around content creation (campaigns in 2021)
