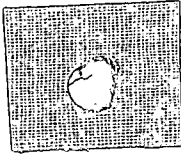

PCI referred to in re airtel is GENE HEYTOW, a partner and co-owner in organization known as Aristocrat Inns of America. This enterprise composed of four co-owners; namely, HEYTOW, Dr. MARTIN L. GECHT, leading Chicago dermatologist, ARTHUR KERSTEIN, Berwyn, Illinois, toy store owner, and MARCEL LUTWAK, Chicago businessman.

Aristocrat Inns of America now own and operate 3 new motels in Chicago's downtown area; namely, the Essex Inn, 8th and Michigan, the Ascot Motel, 11th and Michigan, the Avenue Motel, Roosevelt and Michigan. Also the Acres Motel located on Chicago's near north side. Plans presently underway by this organization to build multi-million dollar motel adjacent to Mc Cormick Place, Chicago's largest and newest exposition center.

9-3198". HEYTOW expressed concern over possible hoodlum connection with motel activities in Chicago and expressed interest in furnishing information to FBI relative to any future infiltration by hoodlums into the Chicago hotel and motel business.

Contact was maintained with HEYTOW and as a result information contained in re airtel was submitted to Bureau.

Contact with HEYTOW will be continued and Bureau will be advised of further developments in this regard.
