Source declined to cooperate and SHERIDAN then said, "We know you are cooperative and are furnishing information but I would like you to furnish it directly to me since we are getting the information late through Washington." Informant said that he received the definite impression from SHERIDAN from this and other conversations that he knew source had been furnishing information to this office.

Re: PHILIP WEISS

Informant was visited by WEISS on 5/12/63.
WEISS brought with him an individual whom he introduced as his younger brother but did not name. WEISS said he was en route to visit with his brother in Connecticut.
He asked the source if he had received any information that he (WEISS) was about to be indicted in Nashville.
Source said WEISS appeared very sick and nervous and was taking pills during the short time they visited. Informant told WEISS that he had read of the indictments returned and assumed the Grand Jury would not return any further indictments. WEISS stated he had received information that the Grand Jury would reconvene and that he would be indicted shortly thereafter. Informant attempted to learn the source of WEISS' information but was unsuccessful. WEISS then left without further discussion of any pertinent significance.

In view of the fact that informant is on the road to recovery and intends resuming his duties for the IBT on a limited basis within the rext two weeks, informant case file is being reopened.
