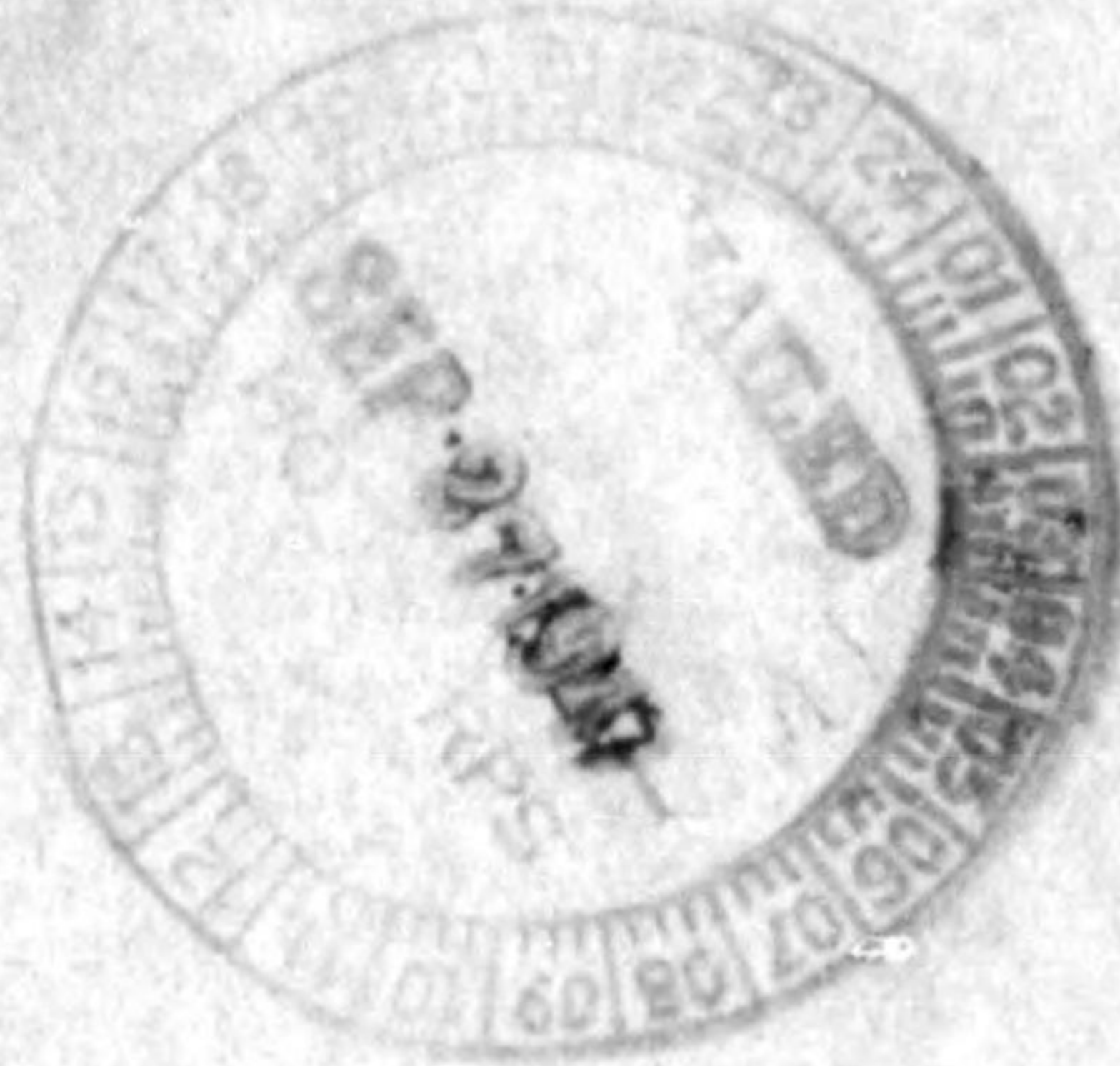

1. It was recently discovered by accident in this prefecture that a machine tool inventoried for reparations in an aircraft plant was looted from the Philippines during the War. The Philippines now claim restitution of this tool exclusive of reparations claims.

2. On the assumption that it was probable that more than one such machine was so inventoried, the prefectural government was directed to investigate the title to reparations machinery. To date investigation has revealed that at least seventy (70) machine tools in this prefecture have been inventoried for reparations from aircraft factories and arsenals which were looted from allied countries during the war. It is anticipated that further investigation will reveal additional machines of this category.

3. Since this situation probably exists in other prefectures as well, it is requested that instructions be issued for withdrawing inventory sheets on such machines, and a procedure outlined for transferring custody to the Civil Property Custodian.

TO : Commanding General, Eighth Army, APO 343

1. Organization of the Civil Property Custodian, General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers, provides for Regional Service Teams of the Property Service Branch, Comptroller Division, to be stationed in conformity with certain existing Military Government Regional Headquarters.

2. Regional Service Teams will perform functions pertaining to properties under custody or control of the Civil Property Custodian which are impracticable to require of the Eighth Army or its agencies by virtue of the technical nature of the work and limitations of man-power. In general, but not in any way to be construed as limitations, the following are functions of Regional Service Teams.

a. Investigation of compliance or non-compliance by the Imperial Japanese Government with directives of General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers, Civil Property Custodian.

b. Verification, authentication and amplification of property records of the Civil Property Custodian.

c. Maintenance of liaison with the Eighth Army and its agencies in the Military Government area.

d. Investigation into property matters as deemed necessary by the Civil Property Custodian.

e. Inspection of warehouses of the Eighth Army or the Imperial Japanese Government in which is stored property under custody or control of the Civil Property Custodian.

f. Such other matters as may be directed by the Civil Property Custodian.

3. Regional Service Teams will vary in strength and composition between regions. They will be composed of War Department Civilian personnel, normally on a permanent basis, but may be augmented by temporarily assigned personnel of the same category.

4. Headquarters of Regional Service Teams will be at the headquarters of the Military Government Regions. Individuals of Regional Service Teams will be placed on detached service from General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers, to the appropriate Military Government Units.

5. It is contemplated that Regional Service Teams will be established only for Military Government Regions in which major property concentrations exist. Functions of Regional Service Teams in other areas will be performed by visiting teams.

6. Members of Regional Service Teams will have the same status as members of Military Government Teams with the exception that work assignments will be made by the Civil Property Custodian in conformity with paragraph 3 above. Directions concerning activities of the Regional Service Teams will be transmitted through Command Channels.

7. It is desired that the Commanding General, Eighth Army, provide for Regional Service Teams in the manner in which Military Government Teams are provided for, furnishing necessary foreign-national personnel, quarters, office space, equipment, transportation, gasoline and supplies commensurate with the mission of the team.




