

No experience is necessary, Our illustrations and instructions tell the story and make the work very easy.

How to Make Flour Paste.

If you wish to make enough paste for a good size room, rub smooth 3 pints of flour in ? quarts of cold water; then add 8 quarts of boiling water and let it boil slowly. Stir constantly for about ten minutes, then let it cool, and when cool add two tablespoonfuls of powdered alum and stir in well. When the paste runs off the brush easily it is ready for use. Be sure there are no lumps in the paste and that it is not too thick to spread smoothly.

How to Prepare New Walls That Have Never Been Papered.

Apply a thin coat of size to new walls that have never been papered. A perfect size for this purpose can be made by soaking 1 pound of glue in cold water for twelve hours and then adding 12 quarts of hot water and a tablespoonful of powdered alum, All kalsomine or whitewash should be washed off with a sponge and warm water before any size is applied on the walls. If the walls have been rough plastered or have not been putty coated, rub off the projecting grains of sand with a block of wood before

sizing. If the walls are very rough, apply a thin paste when the size is dry and let the paste dry thoroughly before papering.

Before papering over a painted wall apply a solution consisting of one part ammonia and six parts water. This will remove all the grease and oil and produce a better adhesive surface for the paste.

Board ceilings and walls should be covered with cheese cloth, which should be tacked at the edges and sized. This shrinks it tight to the wall. At the corners and around the casings the tacks should be placed about 2 inches from the edge and the ends of the cloth pasted down.

Cracked or boarded ceilings or walls can be made smooth, even, airtight and dampproof with our Blue Plaster Cardboard. This is a heavy paper and is tacked on the walls with ordinary tacks. Wall paper can be applied direct to the plaster board the same as to a plastered wall.

enough so that your head will be about 6 inches from the ceiling. The other articles needed are a paste brush, a paperhangers' smoothing brush, a seam roller and a pair of shears. These articles are all listed on page 9 of this book. There are many home substitutes for the professional paperhangers' tools, and if no smoothing brush is at hand a clothes brush or whisk broom can be used. Likewise a bed caster is a good substitute for a seam roller. This is required to press down and smooth the edges where the strips of paper lap over or where two strips are joined together.

Caution.

Do not use the seam roller until the paste is almost dry. Always allow about ten minutes after the paper is hung for the paste to dry; otherwise it will ooze out at the edges and turn white at the lap or butt.

Always paper the ceiling first. If the side walls are papered first they are likely to become soiled while papering the ceiling.

After you have found out the length of your room, unroll the ceiling paper, face up, on the work table, then match and cut it (enough for the celling). Be sure you have at least 3 or 4 inches at each end to come down on the side wall when papering the ceiling (see illustration No. 3). It is absolutely necessary to have the celling paper come down on the side walls a trifle, to cover any space left blank after border is put on, caused by ceiling not always being perfectly level. Allow at least 2 inches at each end in addition to the length of room for this purpose. The larger the design the more surplus is required for matching; this

How to Trim, Match and Prepare Wall Paper.

Get two boards about 8 feet long and 10 or 12 inches wide and lay them side by side with the ends resting on a table or box about 3 feet high. This will serve as an excellent work table. Now make a platform to stand upon while applying the paper to the walls and ceiling. Such a platform can be made by placing a plank or board upon two or more ordinary boxes, which should be just high

surplus will be covered by the border or side wall paper. Before starting to hang, cut sufficient length of paper to cover the entire ceiling. Turn all the paper face down, and you are now ready to apply the paste on the first or top length.

Pasting and Trimming Wall Paper.

Beginning at the left of the table, apply the paste evenly with a paste brush on the top strip of paper. After you have ILLUSTRATION No. 4. applied the paste on about one- side wall paper, matching half the length, fold over (with-perfectly and allowing at out creasing) the part of the the top for the border.


paper that is pasted, using extra care to see that the sides are exactly even. (See illustration No. 1.)

We cannot trim wall paper before shipping, for no matter how carefully the paper is packed there is danger of the edges being roughened, and if the edges are not clean cut it is impossible to do a good job of paperhanging. Wall paper can be easily, quickly and smoothly trimmed with an ordinary pair of shears.

Now apply paste to the other half and fold that over toward the center, the same as the first half. If the strip of paper is longer than the table, paste the left half, and after folding allow the folded end to hang over the end of the table and rest on the floor while you are pasting and folding the other half. You now have an entire strip of paper before you all pasted and folded, and the sides of the paper perfectly even and ready for trimming. Draw the

paper toward you, about 3 inches from the edge of the table, and proceed to trim, commencing at the right (see illustration No. 2). The great advantage of trimming after pasting is that the paste will then be more evenly distributed on the edges. It also takes less time, since you are able to trim two thicknesses at once.

As a guide for hanging the first length of ceiling paper properly, take a piece of chalk or charcoal and draw a line on the ceiling 16 inches from the side wall. This is best done by driving a small nail in ceiling 16 inches from the side wall, at each end of the room before starting to paper. Chalk a piece of cord, tie same to the nails, draw it tight, then take hold of the cord in the center, pull it down and let go. The cord will strike the ceiling and leave a straight chalk line (we show this line in our illustration No. 3 on page 2).

Now guide the paper with your right hand along the chalk line, at the same time pressing the paper to the ceiling with the flat of your hand as you move along, and smoothing it with a smoothing brush or whisk broom. If the ceiling has never been papered, do not fail to first apply a coat of size. Our No. 30C2789 Elastic Sizing, listed on page 14, is recommended. If the walls and ceiling have been previously kalsomined or sized with gloss oil or varnish, add molasses to the paste in the proportion of a quart of molasses to enough paste for a good size room before using it. This will prevent the paper from coming off the walls, which sometimes happens when paper is pasted on walls sized with gloss () or varnish. Always remove kalsomine before staring to paper. This can be very easily done with a sponge and warm water.

Always Hang the Side Wall Paper Before Hanging the Border.

Cut side wall paper same as ceiling. (See preceding page.) The paper should be cut from 4 to 5 inches longer than the length required for the side wall that is to be papered to allow for any waste in the matching. In cutting the side wall paper allow for the space of wall the border will cover.

Be sure to match the pattern of the paper. It is very simple. As you have allowed from 4 to 5 inches in cutting, you can raise or lower each strip or length of paper as the pattern may require. In matching the side wall paper on the work table you will find when a large pattern is selected that there will be at times a waste of 8 to 10 inches that will have to be cut off. The upper end of the side wall paper will be uneven, but the border will cover that. The lower end, which stops at the baseboard, is either trimmed with a base trimmer or with a pair of

Wall paper will not take the place of the other

shears. When using shears, paste the paper in place, close down to the baseboard, use the back of the shears to mark with, running same over top of paper where the top of baseboard and plaster meet, lift the paper a little (the paste still being fresh will permit this), then cut where you have marked with shears, and smooth down with smoothing brush or whisk broom.

To hang side wall paper, arrange your platform or stepladder so it is about 12 inches from the wall. Commence at any door, because corners are often irregular. This will be of great assistance to you in hanging the first piece of side wall paper straight. Then continue around the room until finished. The short pieces can be used over doors and windows.

Take the length of paper that has been pasted, folded and trimmed, mount the platform or ladder, unfold both ends so the entire strip hangs perpendicularly. Holding the paper at both top corners (see illustration No. 4), lean forward, looking down along the edge, and when the paper is properly matched, making the pattern perfect where two strips join, allow the paper to touch the wall, and smooth it down with a smoothing brush or whisk broom.


Occasionally it will happen that a strip may not be perfectly matched after being hung. In such cases remove the strip at once and proceed over again.

How to Hang the Border.

The border should be hung last and may be cut in five or six pieces, if that will make it easier for you to hang. Paste, fold and trim the border in the same way you did the side wall and ceiling paper. Take the folded strip of border, mount your platform or ladder, but do not commence in the corner; unfold the right hand end and have the end lap over on the other wall about 4 inches.

On the cut-out borders the portion cut out is allowed to remain slightly attached to the border. This makes it easy to spread the paste evenly over the edge where the border is perforated. After the paste is applied it is a simple matter to detach the cut-out portion.

Should the ceiling be uneven, measuring from the floor, it is best to draw a chalk line on the wall on a line with the lowest part in the ceiling. This chalk line can be made in the same manner as suggested in the instructions for putting on the ceiling paper, as described on page 3. This will leave the ceiling paper exposed above the border on the wall in some places. Therefore we recommend in our instructions for hanging ceiling paper that it be allowed to come down 2 inches on side wall.



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

Paper Veneer for Walls. The Grain of the Wood Is Printed in Oil Colors on Heavy Manila Paper. Looks Like Genuine Oak Wood but Costs Little.



This new wall covering or veneer is applied to the walls with ordinary paste and when dry a coat of shellac and a coat of varnish are applied over it, resulting in a surface that has the appearance of genuine oak wood.

This Paper Veneer is one of the few wall coverings on the market which gives the quarter sawed oak effect.

The designs are direct copies from the oak itself.

Especially suitable for wall covering where an artistic wood effect is desired at a small cost. Dining room walls may be treated as follows: Paste the paper veneer vertically around the room, below the plate rail, and between each width of paper nail a narrow strip of oak the same shade as the paper veneer. This will serve as a binder as well as dividing the side wall into panels. When dry, apply a coat of shellac and a coat of varnish to the surface, as mentioned above, and you may then wash or polish it the same as any woodwork or furniture.

One S-yard roll will cover 72 square feet of surface, thus costing less than 1 cent per square foot.





The trimmer blade is made of selected tool steel and is mounted in a highly nickel plated casting that fits the hand perfectly. This trimmer runs in a brass mounted channel and will withstand hard usage without becoming bent and useless like many other straight edges. No paperhangers' table is necessary with the Simplex. Three bo ar ds, 8 inches wide and 7 feet long, will make as good a table as the manufactured ones. Lay the boards side by side with the ends resting on tables or other supports, tack the long pieces of zinc at the edge of the board toward you and you have a table ready for cutting paper. 
Paste Wood Filler.



All open grained hardwood such as oak, ash, walnut and mahogany must be filled after being stained and shellacked in order to produce a perfect var-nish finish. For this purpose we recommend our Seroco Paste Wood Filler, which is one of the very best fillers made. It comes in light or dark oak and is very easily applied. Mix together 5 pounds of paste filler with enough stain to color it. to bring the mass to the consistency of heavy paint. It

How to Order, Our Terms, and How to Send Money.

It is a very simple matter to order wall paper from us. On the back of each paper sample we print the name and the price of the paper for the wall, border and ceiling. In making your selection you can refer to colored illustration of the sample. From this you will be able to form an idea as to the appearance of the paper after it has been put on the wall. Use bur regular order blank if you have one, or if you have no order blank use any plain sheet of paper; give us the name of the paper you have selected, also give the catalog number of the paper for the side wall and tell us how many rolls of it you want (remembering there are 16 yards to a double roll); then give the catalog number of the border and tell how many yards of border you want, also give the catalog number of the ceiling paper and tell us how many rolls of it you want, sign your name and give your postoffice address, being sure to also give your street number, postoffice box number or R. F. D. number (if you have one), your shipping point if it is different from your postoffice, and tell us whether you wish the goods shipped by freight, express or parcel post. We advise that goods be sent by freight or express whenever practicable.

We require cash with orders. The best ways to send money are in the form of an express or postoffice money order, bank draft or currency in a registered letter. If you have a checking account at a bank you may send us your personal check if you find it more convenient. We positively guarantee to satisfy you or return your money.

When the distance around room as well as the height have been determined, refer to the table on this page and you will learn how much paper is required.


All our wall paper is put up in double rolls, therefore you will avoid mistakes by not ordering single rolls. Double rolls contain 16 yards of paper each, 18 inches wide. In comparing our prices do not be deceived by the prices quoted by others on single rolls, which contain but 8 yards of paper, or only one-half as much as we furnish.

All our borders are sold at a given price per running yard, and when a customer orders 16 yards of 9-inch border, we send 8 yards of regular width paper, which contains 16 full yards of 9-inch border. Cut the paper along the middle and you will have two pieces, each 8 yards in length. All prices quoted on 9-inch borders are for single yards of one-half the width of the paper.


