



NONAPPROPRIATED FUNDS

1. References:

2. Several instances have recently occurred wherein nonappropriated (welfare and (dry) funds are not being properly audited. These funds are identified as:

- a. Welfare funds (headquarters funds, unit funds)
- b. Sundry funds (club and mess funds, religious funds, locker funds, funds pertaining to Special Services, such as 16mm motion theater funds).
- c. Cash collections (for messes, sale of recreational gasoline, indigenous la').

3. In each case trouble has been caused by:

- a. An inadequate knowledge of regulations pertaining to non-appropriated funds on the part of the auditor.
- b. A lackadaisical manner and method of performance of duty by the auditor.
- c. A failure on the part of the auditor to verify that corrections have been made of deficiencies and irregularities reported by previous auditors.
- d. A failure on the part of commanders and chiefs of staff sections concerned with funds to follow through and see that deficiencies and irregularities reported by auditors are corrected by the custodian.

4. Effective at once and continuing through the fiscal year 1949, commanders and chiefs of staff sections having officers ordered to audit funds will pay particular attention to the following:

- a. That auditors are thoroughly familiar with their duties as required by regulations cited in paragraph 1 above.

b. That during the course of audit the auditor will not only look into the accuracy of the vouchers and account books pertaining to the fund but, where property or stock is connected therewith, verify the existence of same, its condition, accounting records and safeguards.

c. That financial statements rendered by custodians of welfare and sundry funds are complete and accurate and verified by the auditor (a disinterested officer).
