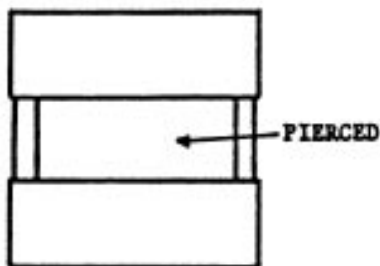

NOTES:

1. The term (REF) refers to the measurements taken from the Government furnished hub or die.
2. Attaching device shall be prong and clutch type. One prong shall be centered on the back of each bar for Dash No. -1 and centered on a horizontal line  $9/64$  inch  $\pm$   $1/64$  inch (0.36 cm  $\pm$  0.04 cm) from the outer edge of the back of each bar for Dash No. -2.
3. Connecting bars shall be as follows:
  - 1:  $3/32$  inch  $\pm$   $1/64$  inch (0.24 cm  $\pm$  0.04 cm) wide by  $1/16$  inch  $\pm$   $1/64$  inch (0.16 cm  $\pm$  0.04 cm) thick.
  - 2:  $1/16$  inch  $\pm$   $1/64$  inch (0.16 cm  $\pm$  0.04 cm) wide by  $3/64$  inch  $\pm$   $1/64$  inch (0.12 cm  $\pm$  0.04 cm) thick.
4. Regular size insignia (Dash No. -1) shall be dapped to a radius of 2 inches  $\pm$   $1/32$  inch (5.08 cm  $\pm$  0.08 cm) on a horizontal plane. The dull flat black enamel for Dash No. -3 shall match FED-STD-595, Chip No. 37038.
5. Insignia may be made from sterling silver for commercial sale and if so, the thickness dimensions are for reference only. A minimum weight of 155 grains for Dash No. -1 and 54 grains for Dash No. - 2 shall govern. The finish shall be as specified except the nickel plating requirement shall not apply.
6. Insignia shall be one piece construction.
