1. At Nakanogo Section, some radical inclined questions such as the enforcement of 9 p. E. S. P. at the sacrifice of labor is unpracticable, are presented by some youths who are working for railway. As a principle, village youths are earnestly approaching to this programme, but some of them who are working for railway or other job than farming have antagonistic stand against the A. E. lessons, being infected by radical idea.
2. The characteristic of this village's A. E. course is:
Only one lesson is presented at each evening, and whole course covers 6 evenings. This is ideal when view from the point of lesson presentation, but when viewed from the point of attractiveness and gathering of people, such could not be highly recommended.
3. The attendants rate at Nakanogo is only 55%, because this village section has railway station and many non-farming houses and its character is somewhat like city at where peoples are indifferent to such education.
4. The attendant rate at this village has been average 80% according to what village authorities told, but 60-70% would be the real percentage it seemed.
5. Kamishibai was presented by district office education official as a recreation, who is devotedly working for this programme.

In my opinion, projection of film is not so effective judging from what I was impressed this evening. The district official came down to this place with projector and screen 3 kinds of films.

1. It is inconvenient to transport the Natico projector and speaker.
2. The supply of electricity requires special arrangement.
3. The contents of films which are produced in foreign country or some years ago have no direct contact with daily life.
4. The audience have too much expectation for the film, because country farmers see the movie only 2 or 3 times in a year and they are eager to be satisfied their expectation for film as attraction rather than education through film.
5. Children used to come up to the place to see the movie and it is too cruel to expell them.
6. If the news reel was projected, it would be very good fun for the farmers, and film service would be more effective, together with educational film.
