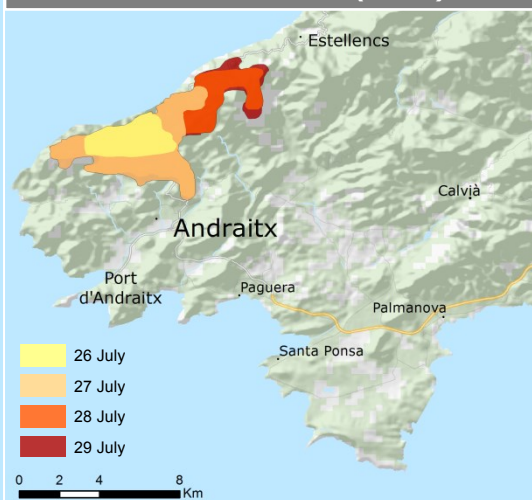


Forest Fire Evolution (EFFIS)



Size of Burnt Area: 2 090 ha
As of 29 July, EFFIS

SPAIN, Mallorca

- On 26 July, a fire started in Andraitx region
- Reported stabilized on 30 July
- As of 31 July morning, it has a danger level 1.

SITUATION

- The fire in the region of Andraitx on the island of Mallorca started on 26 July and was reported stabilized on 30 July. The burnt area was 2 090 ha, as of 29 July, according to EFFIS (the fire time evolution, 26-29 July, is shown in the inset map; the latest burnt area available is shown in the main map, EFFIS)
- As of 31 July morning, the fire is still reportedly stabilized and the Danger Level has been downgraded to Level 1, out of 3 (on 30 July this fire was classified as a danger level 2).
- On 31 July, a new fire broke out in Mallorca near Port d'Andraitx. Local media report (as of 31 July afternoon) that the fire broke out in the morning of 31 July, near the port of Andraitx and has been under control since noon, after having burnt 0.2 ha of pine forest; no houses have been in danger.

FIRE RISK OUTLOOK:

In the next 48h the forest fire risk will remain "High"/"Very High" for NW Mallorca and "Extreme" for the central parts of the island (EFFIS)
