Reference Department's 331, December 18. Swiss Minister,
Tokyo, telegraphs January 30 as follows "Japanese Government
has informed me: 'first. Japan is strictly observing
Geneva Red Cross Convention as a signatory state. Second.
Although not bound by the Convention relative treatment
prisoners of war Japan will apply mutatis mutandis provisions of that Convention to American prisoners of war
in its power.'"
