No claim is made that it is absolutely accurate, but it is as nearly so as great care, diligent research and conscientious effort can make it.

This statement is made to cut the claws of captious critics, who are not infallible in their own criticisms.

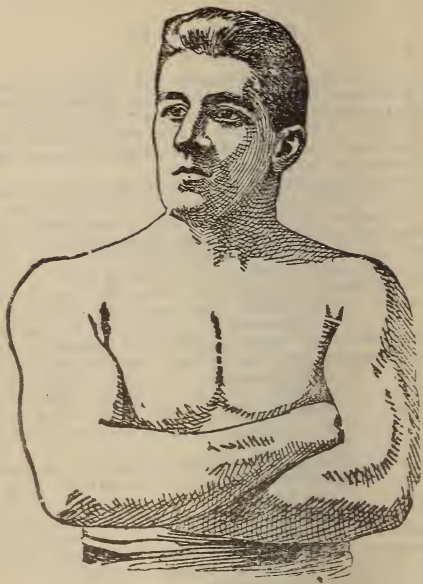
The author has been interested in pugilistic sport for nearly twenty years, and for the larger part of that time has occupied a position where he was able to know and learn of matters connected with it.

The difficulty of obtaining absolutely correct information can be readily appreciated by a moment's thought when it is brought to mind that the attempt is made to record the performances of boxers in distant countries previous to their coming into prominence. In many instances the author found that boxers did not know their own records, and occasionally not even the day of their birth, while they were almost invariably mistaken as to dates, number of rounds, etc.

History is the most disputed of all literature because it claims to give facts, and it is notorious that "facts" are never agreed upon.

This publication, in a moderate way, is a history of the modern ring, and is presented to the public with the assurance that the author has endeavored to be fair and impartial, and has sought to make it as complete and correct as possible.

## MARQUIS OF QUEENSBERRY RULES

1. To be a fair stand-up boxing match in a 24-ft. ring, or as near that size as possible.
2. No wrestling or hugging allowed.
3. The rounds to be of three minutes duration, and one minute time between rounds.
4. If either man fails, through weakness or otherwise, he must get up unassisted; ten seconds to be allowed him to do so, the other man meanwhile to retire to his corner and when the fallen man is on his legs the round is to be resumed and continued until the three minutes have expired. If one man fails to come to the scratch in the ten seconds allowed, it shall be in the power of the referee to give his award in favor of the other man.
5. A man hanging on the ropes in a helpless state, with his toes off the ground, shall be considered down.
6. No seconds or any other person to be allowed in the ring during the rounds.
7. Should the contest be stopped by any unavoidable interference, the referee to name time and place as soon as possible for finishing the contest; so that the match must be won and lost, unless the backers of both men agree to draw the stakes.
8. The gloves to be fair sized boxing gloves of the best quality, and new.
9. Should a glove burst or come off, it must be replaced to the referee's satisfaction.
10. A man on one knee is considered down, and if struck is entitled to the stakes.
11. No shoes or boots with springs allowed.
12. The contest in all other respects to be governed by the revised rules of the London Prize Ring

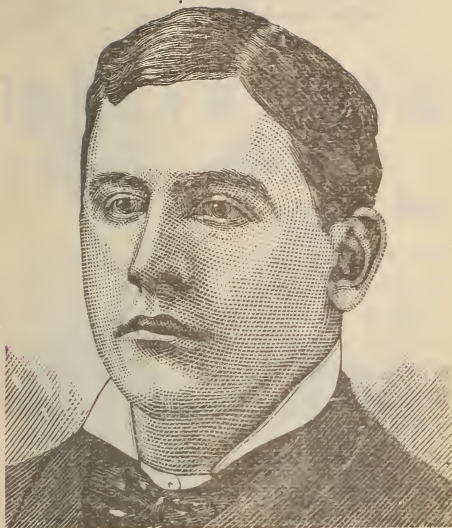

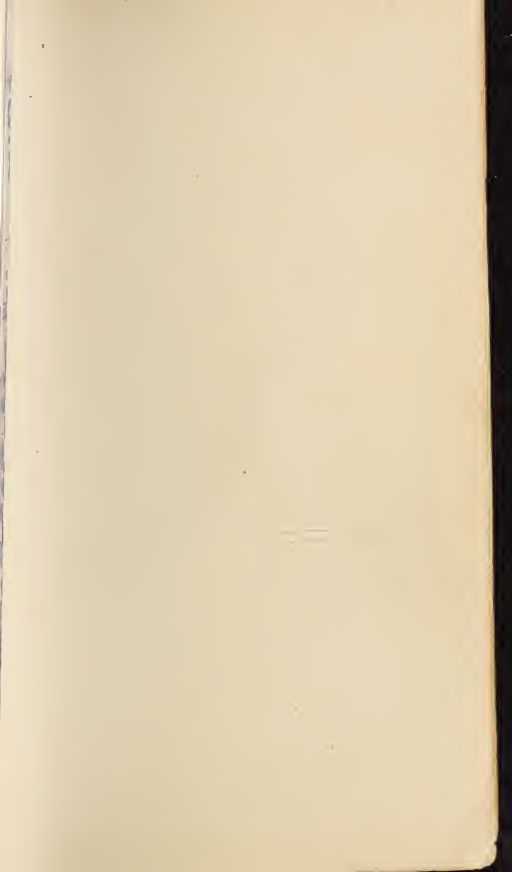

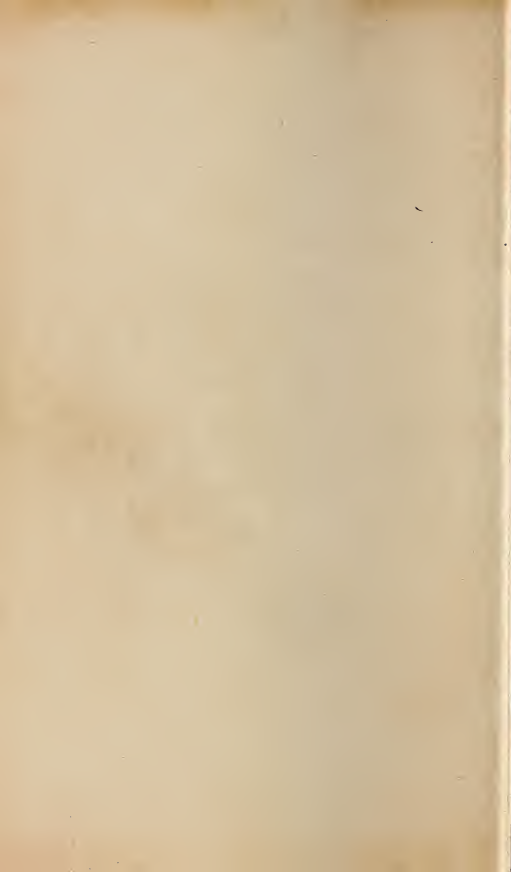
