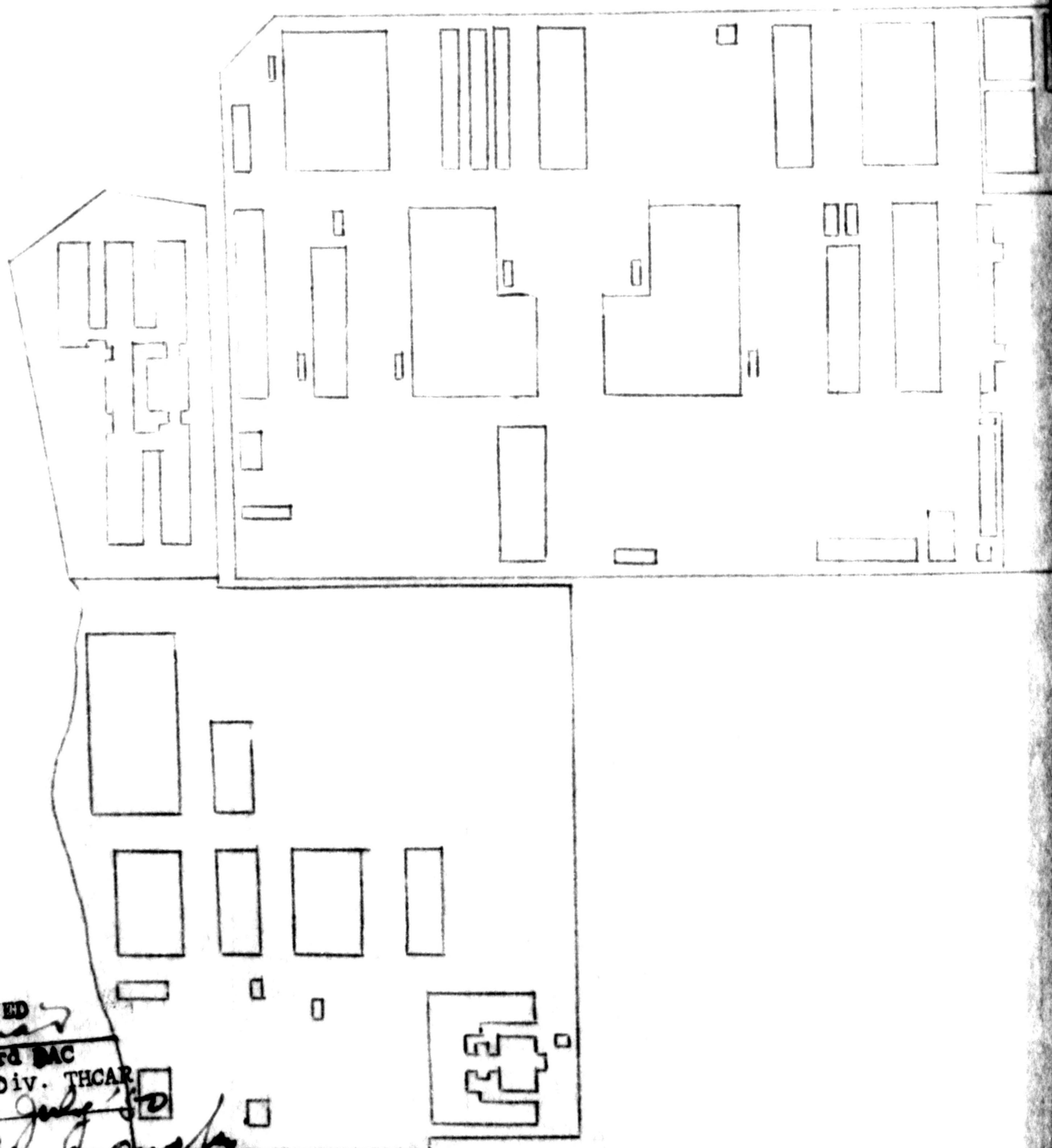

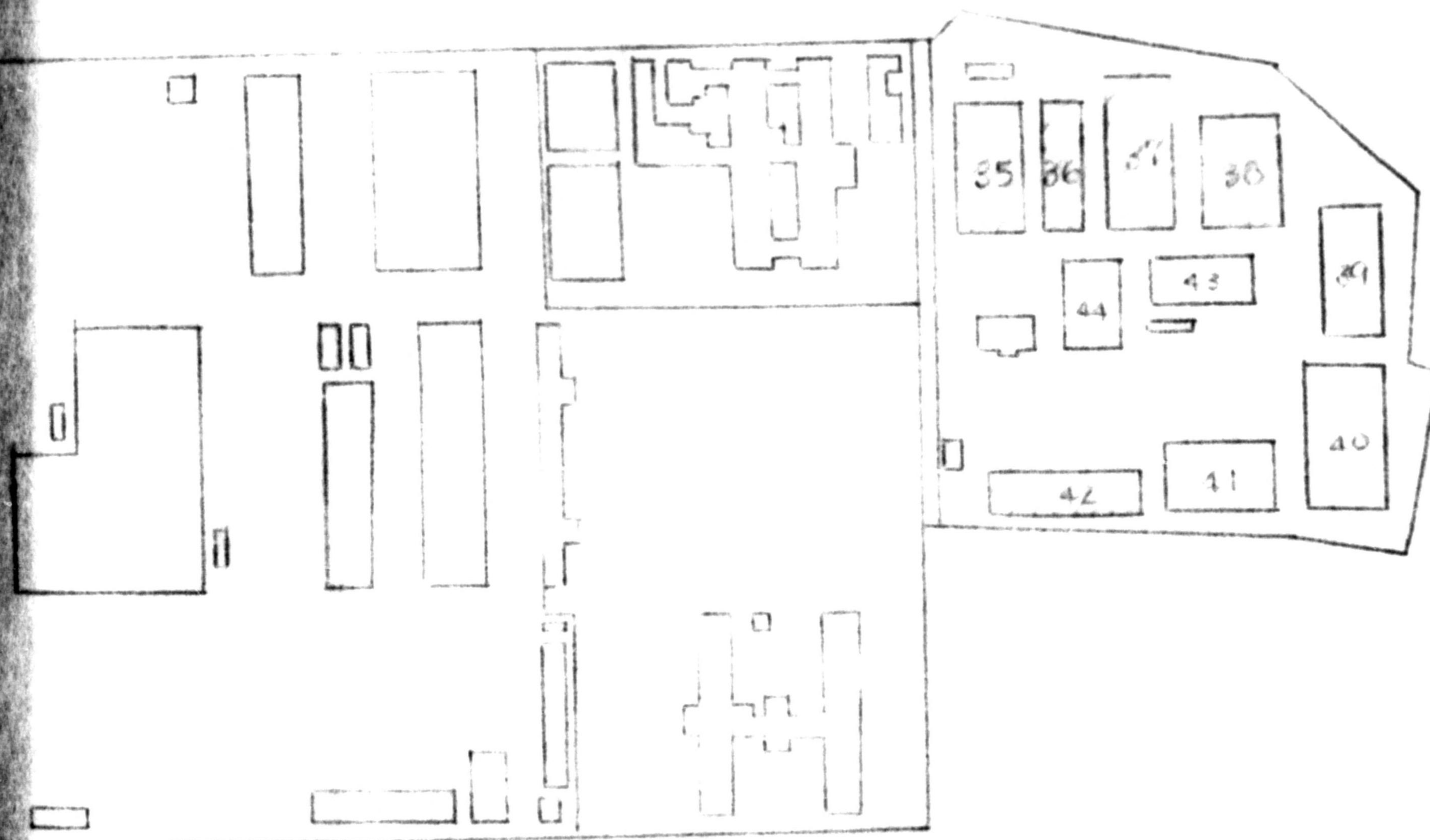
MAP OF FACTORY TOYO BE

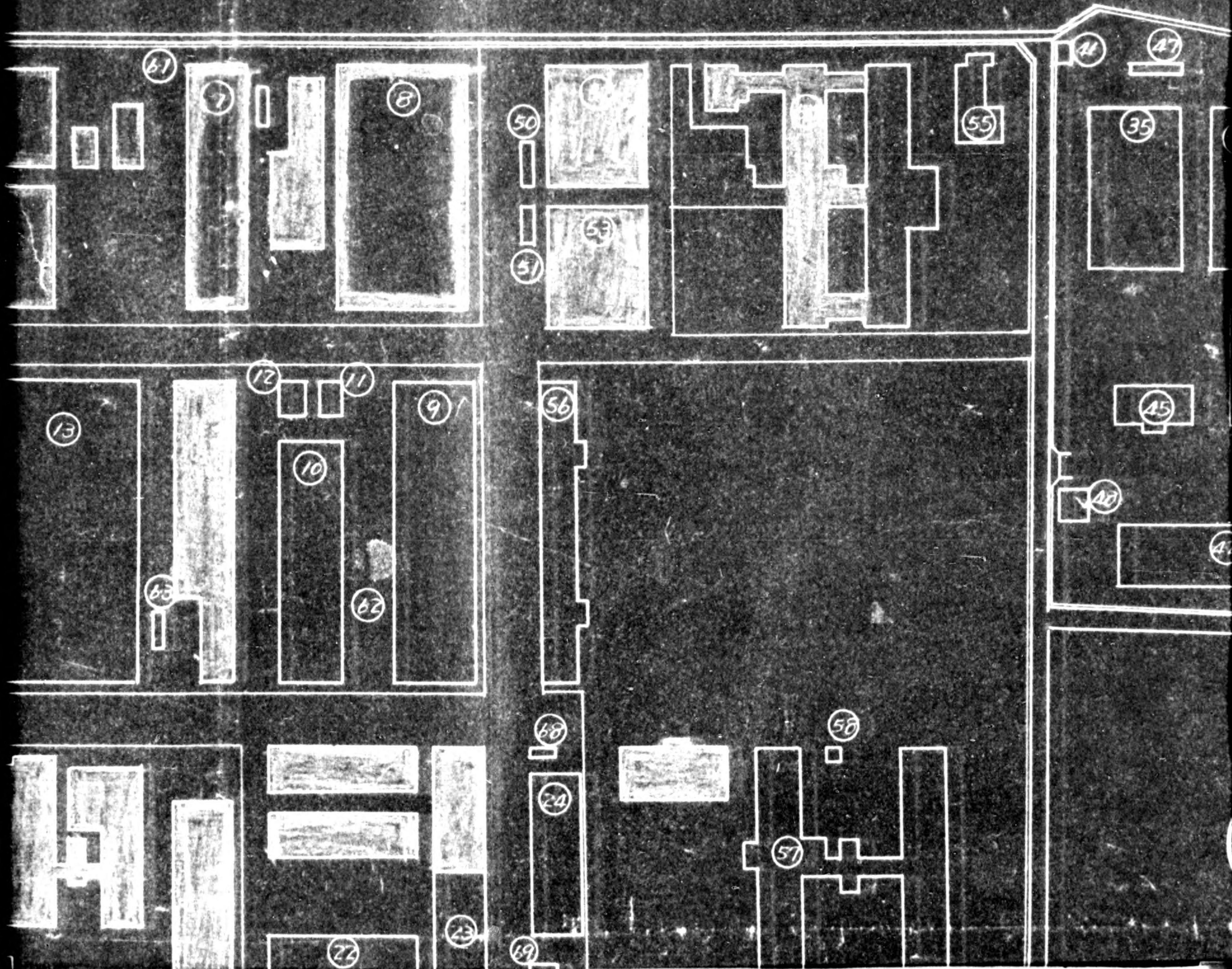


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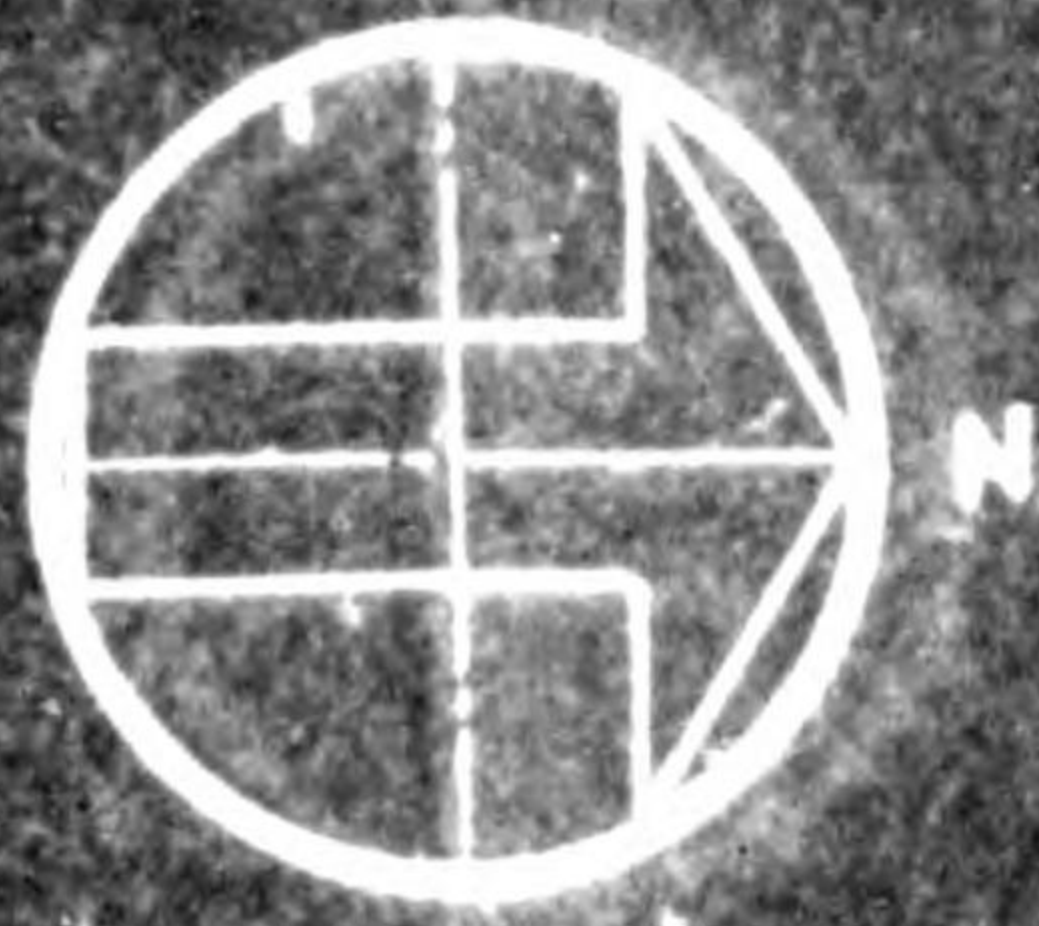
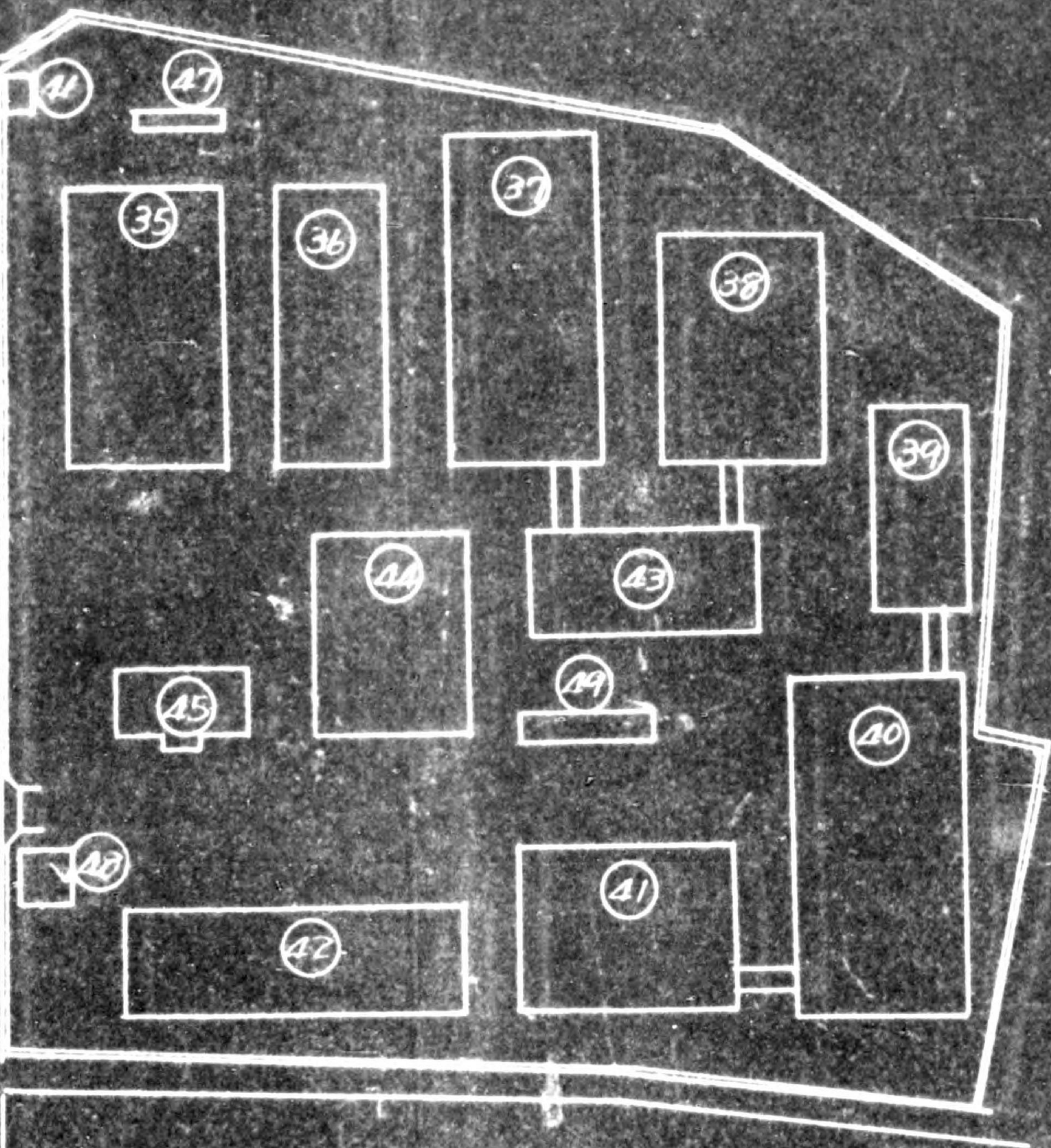
Plan of Kuwana Factory Toyo Bearing Mfg. Co. Ltd. scale 1:200
