Admiral Leahy, acting for the Joint Chiefs of Staff, has forwarded a memorandum, dated 9 June 1947, to the Secretaries of Far and the Navy, setting forth the views of the Joint Chiefs on weapons adaptable to mass destruction, with the request that these views be furnished the Secretary of State. 2. The Secretary of the Havy has prepared and signed a joint transmitting letter which he recommends be signed by the secretary of War and forwarded thereafter to the Secretary of State.
