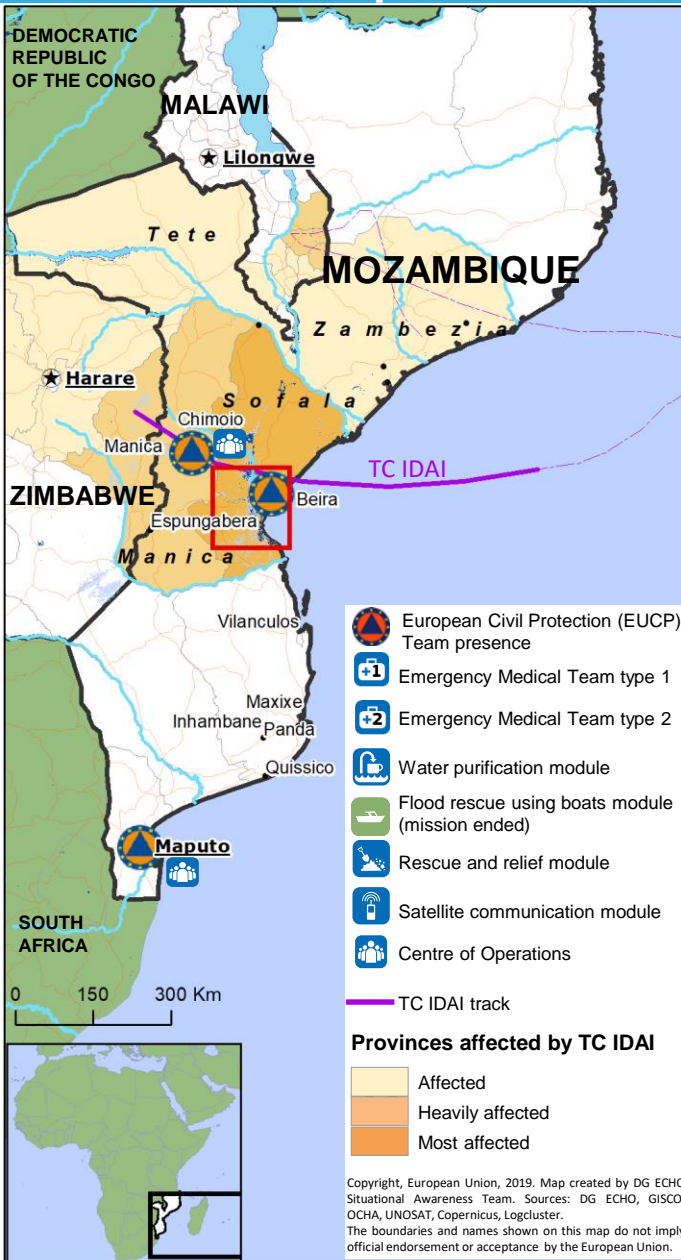


TC IDAI – EU Response

EU RESPONSE

EUR 15 750 000 humanitarian assistance (Mozambique: EUR 9 250 000; Malawi: EUR 2 000 000; Zimbabwe: EUR 4 500 000).
ECHO Office: 5 humanitarian experts + 1 Regional Information Officer.
EUCP Team A (23/03 – 11/04): 14 members (1 team leader, 1 deputy team leader, 3 coordination experts, 2 logisticians, 1 information management expert, 1 WASH expert, 2 TAST members and 2 ERCC liaison officers) + 1 ECDC expert (epidemiologist).
EUCP Team B (11/04 -): 7 members (1 team leader, 1 logistician, 2 information management experts, 1 TAST and 2 ERCC liaison officers) + 1 ECDC expert (epidemiologist).
 1 EU hydrology expert with UNDAC team.

Relief European Civil Protection Mechanism (EUCPM) Modules: 2 water purification modules, 1 satellite communication module, 4 emergency medical teams (2 EMT 2, 2 EMT 1), Flood rescue using boats module, rescue and relief module.
In kind assistance: Medical, hygiene, food, shelter (e.g. tarpaulins, tents, blankets) utility (e.g. solar lights, hand tools, power generators) and water purification supplies.

In addition AT, BE, DE, ES, FI, FR, IE, IT, NL, PT, SE, UK have allocated a total amount of more than **EUR 60 000 000**.
