We regret to learn that Mrs. Leonard Huxley died on Sunday, at Priorsfield, Godalming, in the 46th year of her age. She was Julia Frances, third daughter of the late Thomas Arnold, granddaughter of Dr. Arnold, of Rugby, and sister of Mrs. Humphry Ward. In 1885 she married Leonard, eldest son of Professor Huxley, and she leaves three sons and a daughter. Of the sons, the eldest is scholar of Balliol, and won the Newdigate last year; the second is exhibitioner of Balliol; and the third is on the foundation at Eton.

In the last years of her too brief life, Mrs. Huxley had won, not only the affection of a very wide circle of friends, but an important place in the world of education. The school at Priorsfield, which was planned, founded, and carried on by her (latterly with the help of her partner, Mrs. Burton Brown), is less than seven years old; but already it ranks among the most successful girls' schools in England. It opened in January, 1902, with one boarder and five day pupils; it now has large and beautiful buildings and grounds, and over 80 boarders, many of them the daughters of distinguished and intellectual families. Mrs. Huxley had evidently inherited from her grandfather a gift for teaching and organization; and the surprising success of her school was due in the first place to this, and in the next to her delightful personality. Her teaching of English literature—in which she had taken high honours as a student at Somerville—imbued her pupils with a real love and knowledge of the poets and great prose writers; and her liberal and sympathetic teaching of religion filled the school with a warm spirit of what she herself called "Christian discipleship."
