ALLEGED CUBAN PLAN TO ASSASSINANE PRESIDENT OF PANAMA

CIA HAS NO OBJECTION TO DECLASSIFICATION AND/OR. RELEASE OF CLA INFORMATION IN THIS DOOUMENT. GMB 4464 AS SANMZED

At 4:55 PM, March 17, 1964, Orlando Piedra, formerly connected with Federal Police in Cuba and presently residing New Orleans, Louisiana, advised that about one week ago he received information from a source in Cuba whom he considers reliable that Castro is not satisfied with the way things are going in Panama and for that reason plans to have the President of Panama assassinated to create additional uprisings in that Piedra advised that he furnished the above information by letter to Cohonel Bolivar Ballarino, Chief of the National Guard of Panama-whom he has known for years. Piedra declines to identify the source and has no additional information to report.

This document contains neither recommendations nor conclusions of the Federal Bureau of Investigation. It is the property of the Federal Bureau of Investigation and is loaned to your agency; it and its contents are not to be distributed outside your agency.
