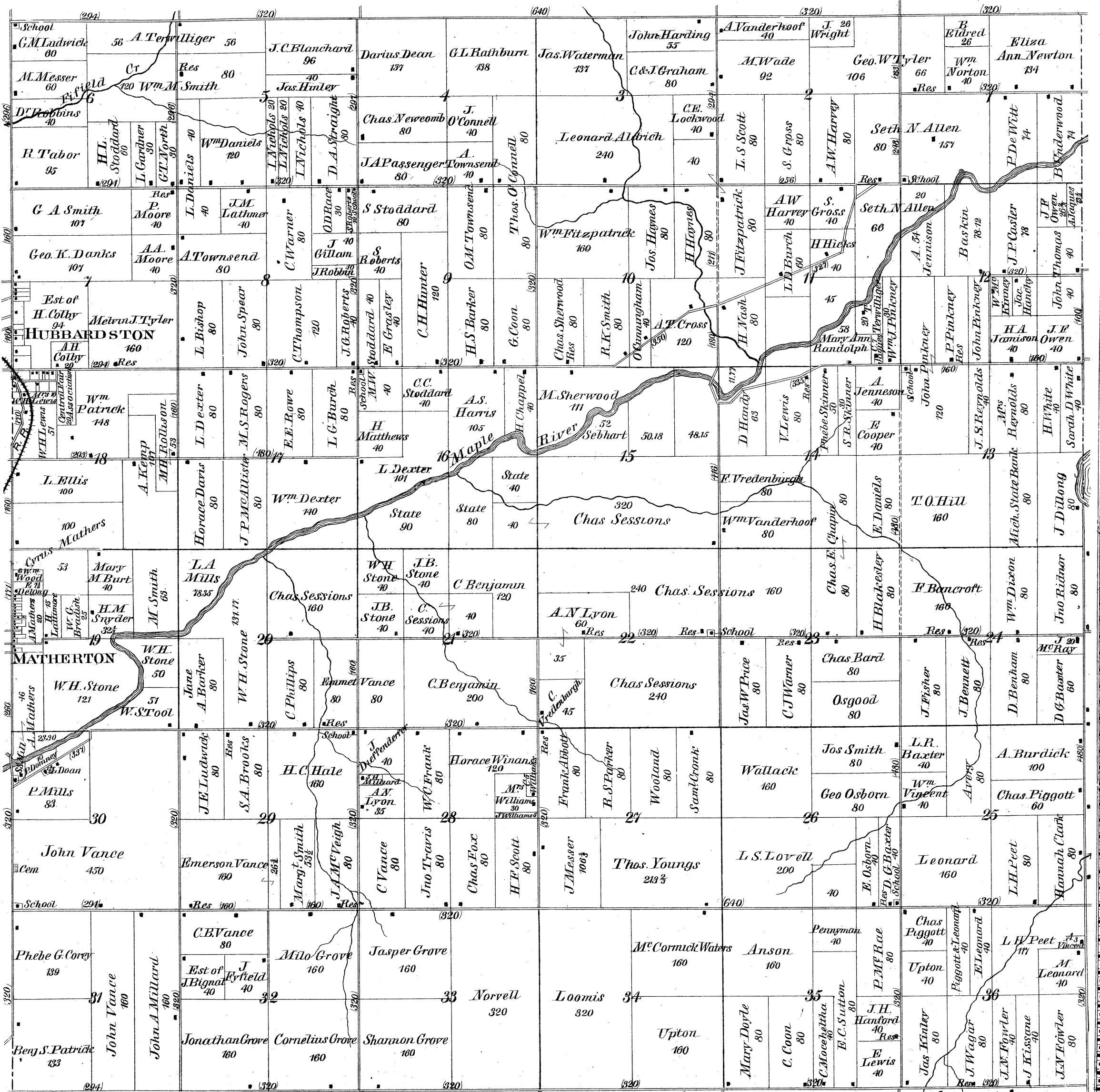
Outline Map of CLINTON CO. MICH.

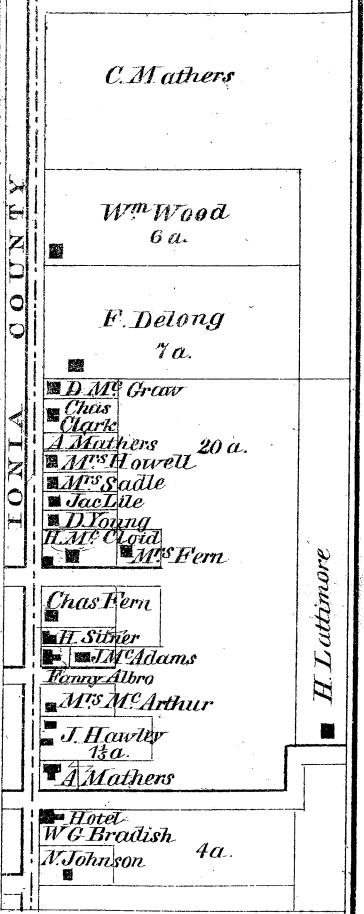
HUBBARDSTON
