Reference is made to our letter dated June 10, 1965, concerning the captioned anti-Castro organization.

On August 13, 1965, a representative of the Central Intelligence Agency, Miami, Florida, furnished our Miami Office information which originated with an unidentified law enforcement officer to the effect that on August 10, 1965, Orlando Bosch Avila, head of the MIRR, was making plans to sink an unidentified merchant vessel which is reportedly scheduled to arrive in Jacksonville, Florida, on August 24 or 25, 1965. Reportedly, Bosch plans to have someone attach a "limpet" mine to the merchant vessel. It was further reported that Augusto Valdes Miranda, also known as "Polo," a Cuban refugee, might be involved in this plot to the extent of permitting Bosch to use his boat bearing Registration Number FL-8477-F in conjunction with the assignment. On August 16, 1965, a Central Intelligence Agency representative advised that his Agency has no interest in this matter and possesses no additional pertinent details.

One of our sources who has furnished reliable information in the past advised on August 16, 1965, that Gervelio Gutierrez Concepcion, also known as "Mimo," on August 14, 1965, indicated he had an urgent need for two time-delay devices which are used to set off detonators for demolition purposes. Our source described Gutierrez Concepcion as the alleged explosives expert for the MIRR. Our source also was recently advised that Bosch has gained possession of a 57 millimeter recoilless rifle and a small quantity of shells for it. This type rifle reportedly has been used by Cuban revolutionary groups in the past on small attack boats. According to our source, Bosch is planning another action against Cuba but has not divulged any details.
