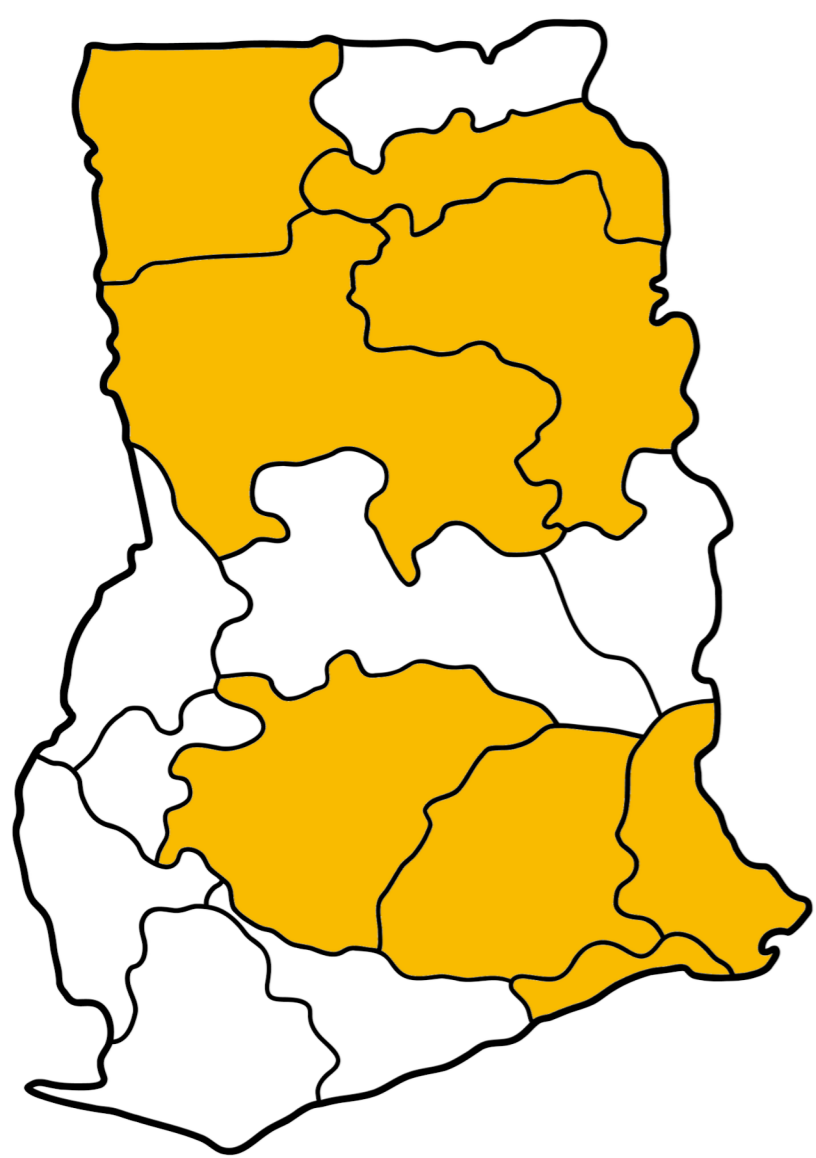




Kiwix4schools Program

With the goal of empowering African individuals with the knowledge and skills to use Kiwix software, Kiwix4schools program aims to eliminate barriers to educational resources in areas with limited connectivity.

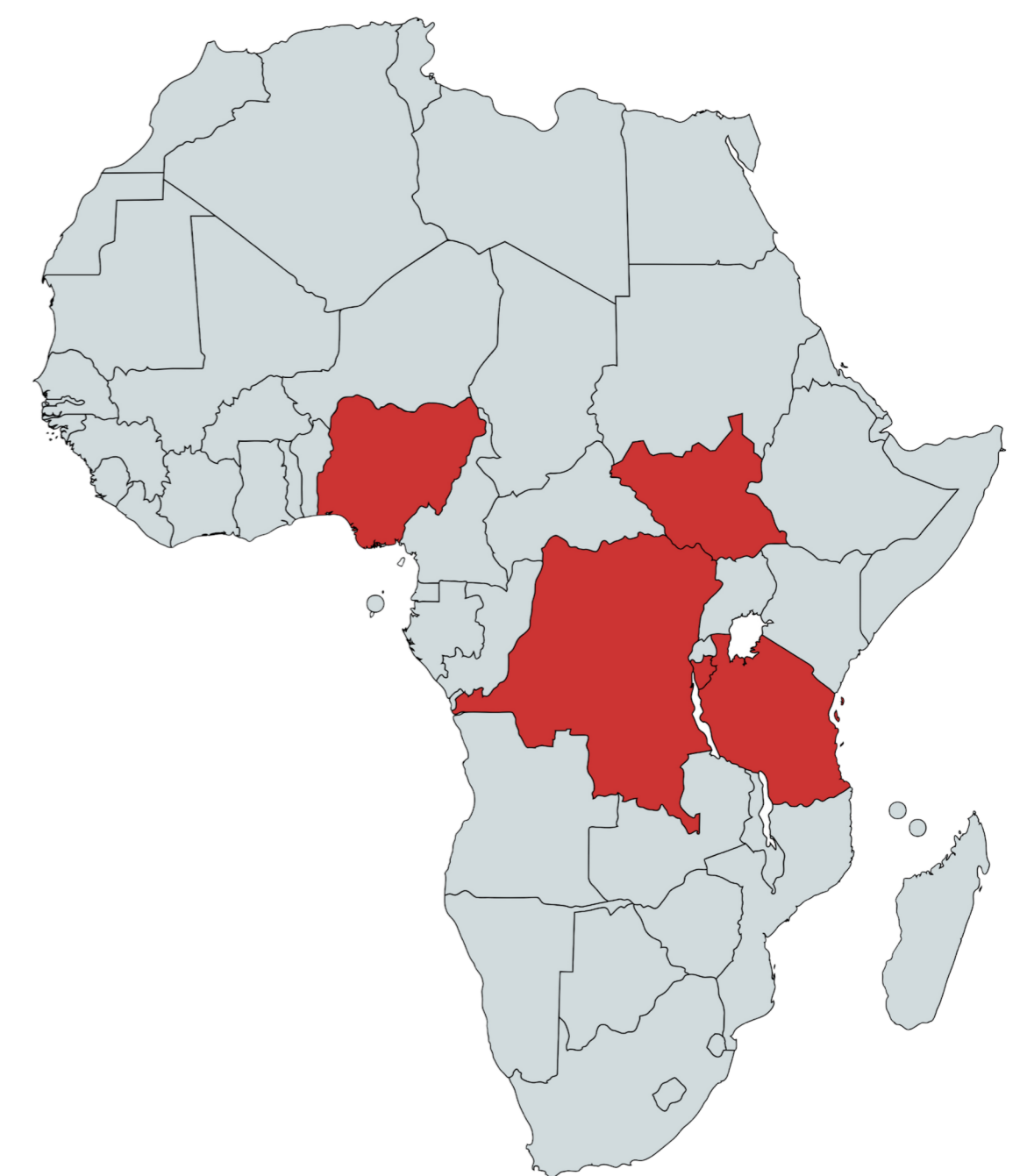


We piloted the initial project in 2016 and so far implemented it in 8 regions in Ghana since the launch of the project.

Following our success stories in Ghana we decided to expand to other African countries through the launch of the Kiwix4schools Africa Mentorship Program.

The virtual launch of the Kiwix4schools Mentorship Program witnessed 115 participants with speakers from the Kiwix, Internet Society and the Ghana Commission for UNESCO.

After the launch, a call was opened up for volunteers to enroll in an online course where lessons were taught on how to install the Kiwix software.

At the end of the course 62 participants from over 10 countries successfully graduated and are now certified as ambassadors to champion and extend the Kiwix4schools project in their respective countries.
