#### (4) Necessity for Movement and Use Machinery and Equipment

We are, at present, engaged in manufacture of hosiery goods, hosiery knitting machines and Sakae type high speed electric code armouring machines. Our characteristic is that we manufacture knitting machines as well as hosiery textiles in one unit.

When we proceed in the study to improve quality of hosiery goods or create a novelty in the way of knitting, we come to the conclusion that, after all, we must improve and better the knitting machine itself.

From this point of view, we established as early as in 1931 a knitting machine laboratory in our factory, and continued up to now to settle this question. This is the reason why we have knitting Machine Section in our Company.

We recently succeeded in a trial make of a fine and efficient knitting machine and are developing a plan for mass production with view to rationalize the aspect of equipments in our knitting mill. The project under plan is to produce for export purpose 50,000 dozens hosiery textiles, 30 high class knitting machines and 7 electric code armouring machines per month.

In order to materialize this plan, we must, first of all, improve the equipments and rationalize production capacity. However, the obstacle to which we are confronted now is the difficulty in obtaining fine and efficient machine tools or equipments, which are the most important factors to put our project in practice. The prime question before us is how to overcome this difficulty.

Viewed in this light, machines and tools as per listed in this Application which are equipped in former Hirakata Arsenal of Osaka Army Arsenal, now Reparation Equipments, are of fine and high efficiency. We consider them most suitable to what we think we could overcome the above-mentioned difficulty.



With the foregoing reasons and plan, we want to be authorized to use Reparation Equipments as per herein listed. It will enable us to accomplish our plan to export our high class hosiery textiles, hosiery machines and electric code armouring machine of superior quality, thereby contribute toward the improvement of Japanese trade.

Annexed is the list of production estimated, materials and labours required, present equipments, as well as mechanical equipments that are necessary to realize the production planned.



5. Reasons for requirement of machines applied for authorized use.

In order to build up a knitting field around the cylinder of any knitting machine where 12 to 26 needles per inch, according to the type of machine, are to be evenly inserted, within allowance of  $2/100$  to  $3/100$  m/m, it requires not only a delicate finish, but also an interchangeableness, and for this working up, a knack of workman is, so to speak, a relic of the old age. A modern minute working machine of high efficiency must be used to build a minute knitting machine, with machine parts made of high degree precision and accuracy.

(A) Grinding machine.

Needless to say, a grinding machine is superior working machine to fully ensure an accuracy in measurement with high speed in operation. With this machine, the finishing work of circular or moving parts of knitting mechanism such as various types of tempered spindle cams of hosiery knitting machine, main shaft of electric code armouring machine, spindles, interior and exterior slastring which support levers and their covers becomes easy. Moreover, the use of this machine increases minuteness of production and durability. In order to favourably compete in overseas market with European or American make in respect of quality of product, it is essential that the interchangeableness of machine parts must be improved. Grinding machine must be equipped with for this purpose.

(a) Universal, Exterior and interior grinding machine.

The use of this machine enables to increase an accuracy and minuteness of finishing work of main knitting mechanism of



machine, such as pulley main shaft, interior and exterior of cylinder cam holder, which is the most important part of knitting machine, decision of exterior diameter of revolving main shaft, and revolving pulley or interior and exterior rings which support levers of code armouring machine. At the same time, application of this machine gives an interchangeableness of machine parts so much so that no other type of machine can take place. Moreover, the machine is no less essential for making or repairing zigs and gauges which is one of the bottle necks of rationalization of production.

(b) Copy Grinding Machine

This machine is essential for finishing work of tempered gauges of various types, adjustment of measurement after temper of so many carved and straight cams of knitting machine (126 cams in case of a machine SA 15" type) and also improvement of miniteness of the finished surface. No other type of machine can take its place.

(c) Inserting gauge grinding machine and screw grinding machine.

These machines are essential for increasing miniteness of machine parts by adopting 'limit gauge system', thereby giving an interchangeableness of machine parts. This will result in increase of production and enables even an unexperienced workman can operate the machine.

(B) Zig drilling machine.

Although there is a slight difference, according to the model,



cam holder of knitting machine have, on the top of its circumference (600 to 800 m/m), 40 to 50 equally devided accurate holes, by virtue of which adjustment of up and down of cams is made. Also, on the same parts, there are about twenty different kinds that need at least two holes which must have an accurate centric distance. To make these holes, we must depend on hole making tools. Knitting machine for export to-day being varied so diverse in their types and sizes, as if they were 'sample machines', manufacture of zig is often necessary.

In case of an electric armouring machine, holes of 12 equally devided (12 feeders), with allowance of  $\pm 2/100$  m/m, are to be made on the circumference of the body of revolving rail of knitting mechanism. Beside this, about ten different types of zigs are used to-day. It can be said that, without equipment of zig drilling machine, manufacture of knitting machine and electric armouring machine is practically difficult, especially when such machines are intended for export which requires a high degree of accuracy and miniteness.

Since we do not have a zig drilling machine in our Mill, we borrow it whenever an occasion arises from Mitsubishi Electric Machine Co. at Itami, and thus fulfilled only a part of our requirements.

(C) Lathe machine.

Most of the lathe machines we are at present using in our Mill have been worn out due to the intense use for making ammunitions



during war time. Both main shaft metals and beds are almost exhausted, and they can be used only depending upon the personal sense and experience of workman, without which they cannot be used at all. It may be said that the machines now do not suit for making a high class minute machine such as hosiery knitting machines. They are also uneconomical and must be replaced without using further. Lathe machines owned by civilian companies available on the market are, generally speaking, undependable in respect of the degree of accuracy and minuteness. Therefore, we must look for those possessed by Government quarters.

(D) Drilling Machine and Radial Drilling Machine

Those machines used by us at present are almost worn out in the same way as lathe machines above explained. Therefore, we want to use them for making rough holes, and for minute work, we want to use the machines of high degree minuteness as owned by Government sources which has the durability. If we come to possess such machines, we shall be able to make high degree minute machine parts that can favorably compete with those of European make, with the result that the machines made are superior in their quality.

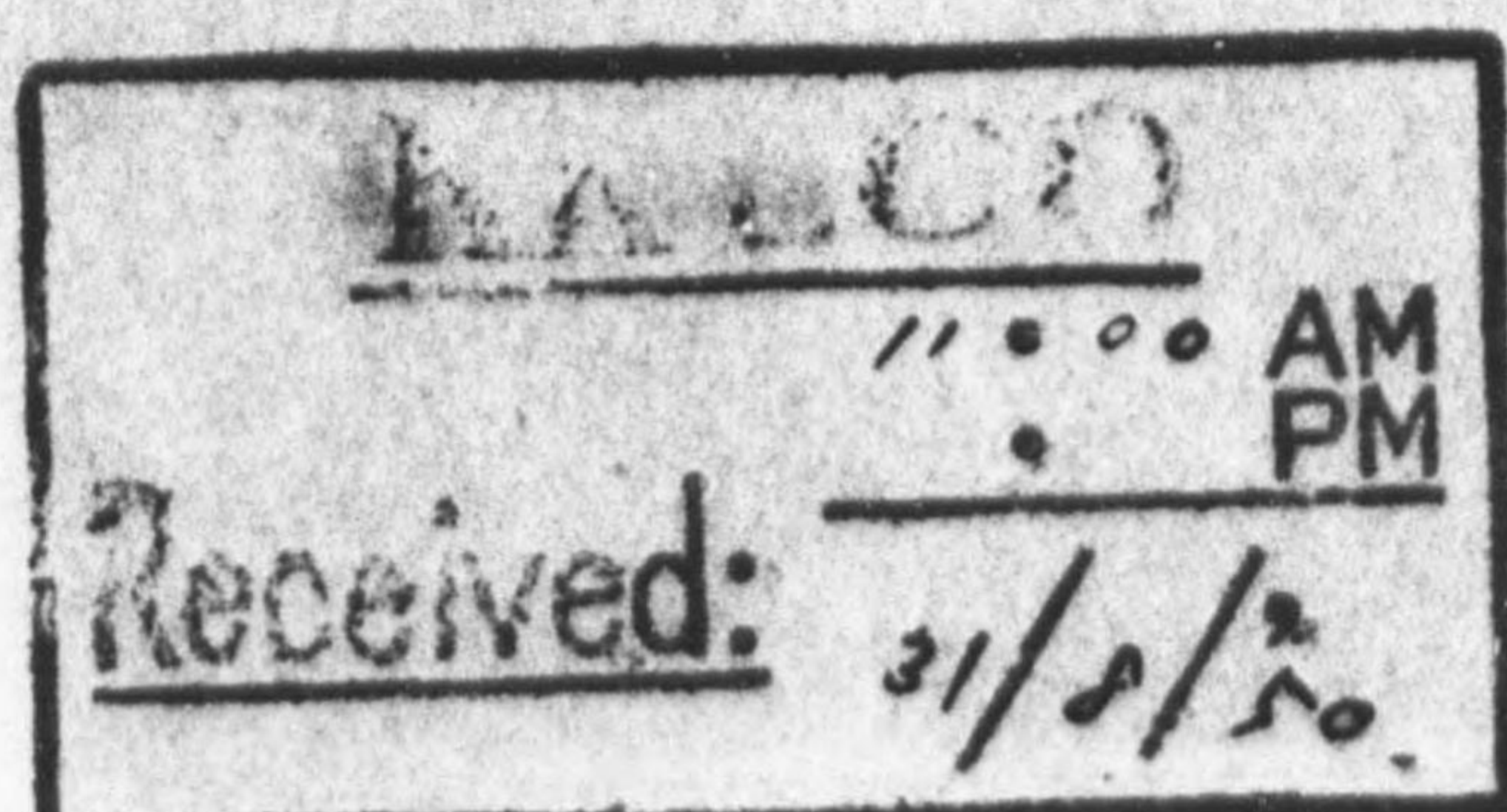

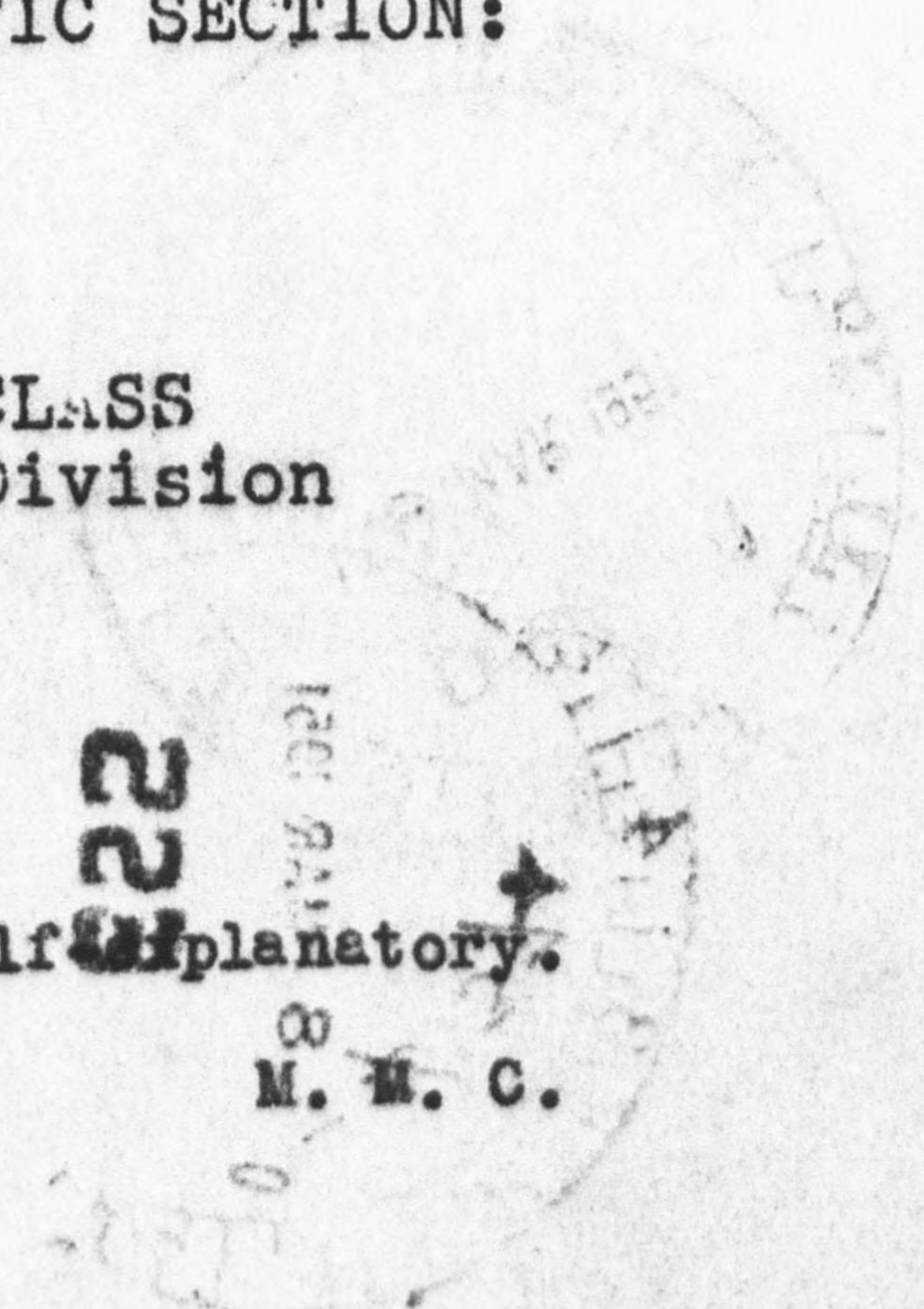

a. General description of the firm:

Ever since establishment in 1934, the firm of Yoshihara Oil Mill has mainly engaged in pressing, refining of vegetable oils, additionally manufacturing of soap, margarine and paper. Nishinomiya factory has a land of 22,000 tsubos, a floor space of 8,000 tsubos and 450 employees. The present machinery and equipment of factory are shown in annex.

b. Plan:

The monthly oil output of Nishinomiya factory is about 2,500 tons at present. In accordance with steadily increasing demand, we have a program raising to 55% operating rate from 30 % by improvement of the existing equipment. We have also the production increasing plan, by construction of another extraction factory.




