SUBJECT: HARADA, Kumakichi

Address: Believed to be in custody of British in
Singapore.

Was Lt Gen and Commander of the Special Service Section
in Shanghai at the time MATSUI was Commander-in-Chief of the
Expeditionary Force in Central China.

File 99, Serial 289, states Subject admitted to Sugamo
Prison 24 March 1946.

File 00, Serial 266 states Subject admitted to Sugamo
in connection with execution of three Australian fliers.

File 99, Serial 573, is an IPS concurrence for transfer
of Subject from Sugamo to Singapore.

File 99, Serial 895, indicates Subject discharged from
Sugamo 13 June 1946.

File 350, Serial 5, indicates TAJIRA thinks Subject was
primarily responsible for setting up provisional Nanking
Government.

Same information is indicated in File 360, Serial 44,
File 405, Serial 64 and File 388, Serial 5.

The check of IPS files revealed another HARADA with the
same first name but listed as a colonel. This may be same
Subject at an earlier period in his career. Two mentions are
made of him as a colonel: File 426, Serial 2, states Col. HARADA
directed Lt Col KUSUMOTO, Naritaka to order SATOMI to organize
an opium distribution agency; file 234, Serial 21 states Col.
HARADA may have conducted opium traffic but only with the know-
ledge of General HATA.
