SUBJECT: Application for Permission to Extend Period of Domestic  
Consumption of Precious Metals in the Second Quarter  
of 1947

- c/ Manufacturing of medicines;
- d/ Platinum nets;
- e/ Pyrometers, hydrometers and **related** measuring instruments;
- f/ Medical and Dental use;
- g/ Platinum crucibles and plates.

4. Platinum released to authorized representatives of the Ministry of Finance by reference 1b above, but unused in the amount of 3,126.22 grams, will be retained on hand in the custody of the Ministry of Finance, pending instructions from General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers.
