Governments focus on platform liability for user-generated content

- Regulatory and legislative pressure on platforms to police user-generated content
- Range of targeted content is getting broader, includes misinformation, extremism, copyright, etc.
- Regions with emerging communities are increasingly producing concerning public policy.

Signed coalition letter (coordinated by startup advocacy group Engine) expressing concern about the potential impact of FOSTA (US Congress) on online platforms.
Access to knowledge	 Submitted comments and a letter to the Committee of Experts for a Data Protection Law for India explaining the importance of balancing privacy and access to knowledge in the implementation of a new right to be forgotten. Participated in Conectados al Sur symposium in Costa Rica, which focused on inclusion of youth and children online in Latin America. Participated in the 2nd Internet & Jurisdiction Conference, advocating for an internet without borders, in which users in different countries would have access to different kinds of content. Also briefed ED for her intervention at the conference. Hosted and organized a panel at SXSW on the effects of global content removals on access to knowledge online.

What you learned doing public policy:

Did anything unexpected (good or bad) happen?

We increased our engagement on CDA 230, in response to the progress (and eventual passage) of SESTA/FOSTA in the US Congress. This is the first incursion against the protections offered by CDA 230, upon which we depend. We are evaluating how we should increase Wikimedia's voice in future legislative actions in the US that affect our mission.

What would you do differently if you had to do it again?

Did you struggle with anything?

We struggle with a lack of available research on community removal of illegal content on our projects, and with a lack of resources to commission that research. A better understanding of the processes of detecting and removing of harmful or illicit content on our platform would allow us to make better, more compelling policy arguments.
