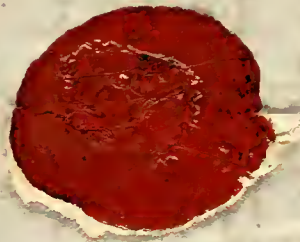
In pursuance of a promise given
